Dear Sir:

I am in receipt of your communication under date September 30th, enclosing a copy of a letter from F. E. Williams, county clerk of Ye¹lowstone county. The questions asked by Mr. Williams are as to the proper charges for the satisfaction of a chat'el mortgage, and for filing an assignment of a chattel mortgage. In regard to the satis-

faction of chattel mortgage, I am of the opinion that it should take the same rate as any other mortgage, as provided by Chapter 117 of the Session Laws of the 12th Legislative Assembly. That provision provides as follows:

"For each entry of discharge or satisfaction of mor'gage, lien or other instrument on the margin of the record thereof, or upon the original instrument and noting the same in index, twenty-five cents."

In other words, I think the term "mortgage" in this Section is used in a generic sense, and would include chattel mortgages, as well as mortgages of real estate.

As to the assignment of the mortgage, I think that the provision reading,

"For filing and indexing each chattel mor'gage, and writ of tachment, execution, certificate of sale, lien or other instrument, required by law to be filed and indexed, fifty cen's." would apply.
