

**Billiard Tables—License of.**

Section 2758 of the Revised Codes of 1907, requiring license to be paid for billiard tables, has not been repealed by Chapter 79 of the Laws of 1917.

My dear Mr. Erickson:

Your letter, inquiring whether Section 2758 of the Revised Codes of 1907 requiring licenses to be paid for billiard tables is still in effect, has been received.

This section has never been either directly or indirectly repealed and is in full force and effect, and the counties generally collect the licenses therein required. The section was cited in the case of *Equitable Life Assurance Company v. Hart*, 55 Mont., at page 84, where the court refers to the fact that this section was not repealed by Chapter 79 of the Laws of 1917, which repealed certain other sections of the same chapter.
