Dear Mr. Brown:

You have requested my opinion as to whether it is the duty of the state examiner to examine the books and records of the secretary and treasurer of the state board of pharmacy.

For the reasons assigned in the opinions of the Attorney General, Vol. 15, pp. 72 and 230, it is my opinion that it is not the duty of the state examiner to examine such books and records.
