8 A JOINT RESOLUTION OF THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF
9 REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MONTANA TO OPPOSE THE VETO
10 OF THE FEDERAL STRIP MINING BILL BY PRESIDENT FORD.

12 WHEREAS, President of the United States, Gerald Ford,
13 vetoed the federal strip mining bill, Senate Bill 425 of the
14 United States Congress, and

15 WHEREAS, both houses of the Congress of the United
16 States supported the bill, and

17 WHEREAS, the state of Montana will be greatly affected
18 by this veto, and

19 WHEREAS, this veto is an usurpation of the right of the
20 people to minimal environmental protection.

22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE
23 OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

24 That these legislative bodies adamantly oppose the veto
25 of the federal strip mining bill by President Ford.

2 be sent by the Secretary of State to the President of the
3 United States.
