HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 5

INTRODUCED BY BARDANOUE

A JOINT RESOLUTION OF THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MONTANA PRESCRIBING THE DUTIES AND COMPENSATION OF LEGISLATIVE OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES.

WHEREAS, it is necessary to establish the salaries and positions of legislative officers and employees for the Forty-fourth Legislature.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

(1) That the following positions are paid for the number of days as authorized by the legislative administration committee of each house, at the indicated compensation per day, which may be computed on an hourly basis for accounting purposes:

- secretary of the senate.....\$42-\$46/day (includes \$15 per diem for expenses)
chief clerk of the house.....\$42-\$46/day (includes \$15 per diem for expenses); and
sergeant-at-arms.....\$41-\$45/day (includes \$15 per diem for expenses)

chaplain.....\$12/day

(2) The following positions are compensated for the number of hours for the calendar week as authorized by the legislative administration committee of each house at the indicated hourly wages. Each employee shall receive a five SEVEN percent (5%) (7%) increase for each year of legislative experience not to exceed two (2) years.

4 (3) The duties of the secretary of the senate, the

5 chief clerk of the house, and the sergeants-at-arms, are as

6 prescribed by law, by legislative rule, and by the presiding

7 officer of each house. The duties of committee researchers

8 and secretaries are as prescribed by the chairman of the

9 employing committees. The duties of the business manager

10 and public information office are as prescribed by the joint

11 committee on legislative administration. The duties of

12 every other position scheduled in the preceding section are

13 as prescribed by the committee employing the person in such

14 position; and

15 (4) The salaries specified in this resolution shall be

16 paid for every day of the Forty-fourth Legislature during

17 which the employee works. The presiding officer of each

18 house may authorize the legislative administration

19 committee, when necessary, to continue the employment and

20 compensation of officers and employees for a period not to

21 exceed fifteen (15) days immediately after the adjournment

22 of a session of the legislature and in addition for not more

23 than ten (10) days prior to the session, except for the

24 position of business manager.
