6 A JOINT RESOLUTION OF THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF
7 REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MONTANA REQUESTING THE CIVIL
8 AERONAUTICS BOARD OF THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO
9 ESTABLISH REGULATIONS WHICH WOULD PROVIDE FOR CONTINUED AIR
10 SERVICE DURING PERIODS WHEN AN AIRLINE PROVIDING SOLE
11 SERVICE IS SHUT DOWN; AND REQUESTING THE MONTANA
12 CONGRESSIONAL DELEGATION TO INTRODUCE LEGISLATION WHICH
13 WOULD ABOLISH MUTUAL AID PACTS AMONG AIRLINES.

15 WHEREAS, the availability of commercial air transport
16 plays an important role in Montana's economic well-being,
17 and

18 WHEREAS, many Montana cities do not have competitive
19 air service on major routes, and

20 WHEREAS, any prolonged shutdown of service results in
21 great economic dislocation to the people who rely on the
22 airline for transportation, and

23 WHEREAS, a prolonged shutdown of service results in
24 severe economic hardship to the airports which are dependent
25 on landing fees for much of their financing, and

1 WHEREAS, the citizens of Montana have within the past
2 three (3) years experienced the unhappy effects of a
3 prolonged shutdown, and

4 WHEREAS, proper planning now can prevent a recurrence
5 of past problems.

7 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE
8 OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

9 That the Chairman of the Civil Aeronautics Board of the
10 Department of Transportation be requested to establish
11 regulations which will provide air service during periods of
12 shutdown.

13 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Montana Congressional
14 Delegation be urged to introduce legislation which would
15 have as its purpose the abolishment of mutual aid pacts
16 which tend to discourage quick settlement of labor disputes.

17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Secretary of State be
18 directed to send copies of this resolution to the Secretary
19 of Transportation, the Chairman of the Civil Aeronautics
20 Board, and the members of the Montana Congressional
21 Delegation.
