4 A JOINT RESOLUTION OF THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF
5 REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MONTANA REQUESTING THE
6 COMMITTEE ON LEGISLATIVE PRIORITIES TO ASSIGN AN APPROPRIATE
7 COMMITTEE TO STUDY THE PURPOSES, FUNCTIONS, AND OPERATIONS
8 OF THE MILK CONTROL BOARD AND TO MAKE RECOMMENDATIONS TO THE
9 FORTY-FIFTH LEGISLATURE.

11 WHEREAS, since 1939 it has been the policy of this
12 state to promote, foster, and encourage the intelligent
13 production and orderly marketing of dairy products; to
14 eliminate speculation and waste in the dairy industry; to
15 make dairy product distribution as direct and efficient as
16 possible; and to stabilize the marketing of dairy products;
17 and

18 WHEREAS, a Milk Control Board was established to
19 execute the state policies with regard to dairy product
20 production and marketing; and

21 WHEREAS, the Milk Control Board has exercised
22 considerable power in its efforts to effect the state
23 policies and promote the public welfare; and

24 WHEREAS, the state policy as carried out by the Milk
25 Control Board may no longer serve the needs of the people of

1 this state.

3 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE
4 OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

5 That the Committee on Legislative priorities is
6 requested to assign an appropriate committee to study the
7 purposes, functions, and operations of the Milk Control
8 Board and recommend to the Forty-fifth Legislature whether
9 the Milk Control Board should be abolished and if so, what,
10 if any, of its functions should be transferred to another
11 agency.
