1 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE  
2 OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

3 That the Administrator of the Environmental Protection  
4 Agency, Russell Train, and the Regional Director of the  
5 Environmental Protection Agency are called upon to gather  
6 baseline data on the quality of air and water in the Poplar  
7 River area.

8 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Environmental  
9 Protection Agency ascertain what effects, if any, the Poplar  
10 River Project will have upon the health and well-being of  
11 American citizens living in the Poplar River area.

12 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that copies of the results of  
13 such study be forwarded to the Secretary of State of the  
14 United States, the Governor of Montana, and the Director of  
15 the Montana Environmental Quality Council.

16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Secretary of State be  
17 instructed to send copies of this joint resolution to the  
18 Administrator and the Regional Director of the Environmental  
19 Protection Agency, and to the Honorable Mike Mansfield, and  
20 Lee Metcalf, Senators from the State of Montana, and the  
21 Honorable John D. Melcher and Max Baucus, Congressmen from  
22 the State of Montana along with a request that copies of  
23 this resolution be transmitted to the appropriate federal  
24 agencies.
