 18 WHEREAS, the legislature is directly responsible to the
 19 people of Montana for the taxes levied upon them, and
 20 WHEREAS, the legislature must be aware of governmental
 21 effectiveness in order to provide needed services while
 22 keeping taxes at a level that is bearable by the people.

 24 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE
 25 OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

1 That, the Committee on Priorities, under section
 2 43-717(3), R.C.M. 1947, consider and request that a joint
 3 standing subcommittee be assigned to study the effectiveness
 4 of government agencies and devise a system of accountability
 5 that will accurately measure service output in relation to
 6 tax dollar input.
 7 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that copies of this joint
 8 resolution be transmitted by the Secretary of State to the
 9 Committee on Priorities and the Executive Director of the
 10 Legislative Council.
