 2 INTRODUCED BY MCKITTRICK, LOCKREM, KIMBLE

 4 A JOINT RESOLUTION OF THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF
 5 REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MONTANA URGING THE
 6 DEPARTMENT OF HIGHWAYS TO HELP DECREASE UNEMPLOYMENT BY
 7 OFFERING A SUFFICIENT NUMBER OF HIGHWAY PROJECTS FOR BIDDING
 8 AND CONSTRUCTION IN THIS CONSTRUCTION SEASON.

 10 WHEREAS, recent Presidential action has released
 11 previously impounded funds marked for construction of
 12 highway projects across the nation; and

13 WHEREAS, awards of those formerly impounded funds will
 14 be made on a priority basis to states whose highway
 15 construction projects are in an advance state of design; and

16 WHEREAS, the Montana Department of Highways has
 17 announced plans to offer for bid more than sixty million
 18 dollars (\$60,000,000) in projects before June; and

19 WHEREAS, those projects once begun will employ
 20 thousands of Montana construction workers who are presently
 21 unemployed.

 23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE
 24 OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

25 That the Montana House of Representatives urges the

1 Department of Highways to follow through on its announced
 2 plan and rapidly prepare highway projects for construction
 3 in the early part of this year's construction season as a
 4 means of reducing the state's unemployment problem.
