1 SECTION 3. ADMINISTRATIVE FLEXIBILITY AND MATCHING
2 FUNDS. THIS APPROPRIATION MAY BE USED AT EITHER OF THE TWO
3 MAIN UNITS OF THE UNIVERSITY SYSTEM AT THE DISCRETION OF THE
4 REGENT'S TASK FORCE ON HANDICAPPED STUDENTS. IF MORE FUNDS
5 SHOULD BECOME AVAILABLE FROM OTHER SOURCES, THEY MAY BE
6 EXPENDED IN ADDITION TO THIS APPROPRIATION.
