BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Special parking permits for physically
handicapped persons -- application, fee, issuance. (1) The
registrar's bureau, department of justice, shall issue a
special parking permit to a person who:

(a) holds a valid Montana driver's license and owns a
motor vehicle, other than a commercial vehicle, and has a
permanent physical handicap that impairs his mobility when
not in a motor vehicle; or

(b) regardless of whether he holds a driver's license
or owns a motor vehicle, has a permanent physical handicap
that impairs his driving ability and impairs his mobility
when not in a motor vehicle to such an extent that he needs
to be driven by another person to a destination.

(2) The parking permit issued under this section, when
displayed, entitles a person to park a motor vehicle in

special parking spaces reserved for handicapped persons.

(3) The registrar's bureau shall provide a card or
plate that may be displayed in a motor vehicle to indicate a
parking privilege granted under this section. The card or
plate shall be prominently displayed in the windshield of a
vehicle when the parking privilege is being used.

(4) Applications for a special parking permit may be
made to the registrar's bureau on forms provided by the
bureau, which must require sufficient information to
determine eligibility for a permit. The application must be
accompanied by:

(a) a certificate from a licensed physician describing
the extent of the applicant's disability; and

(b) a fee of \$1.

(5) Applications shall be available at the office of
the county treasurer in each county and directly from the
registrar's bureau.

(6) No one applicant may receive more than one permit.

(7) A permit expires on December 31 of the year of
issue.
