 9 for legislative employees and attaches which recognizes the
 10 need to compensate those employees on a similar basis to
 11 other state employees.

12 (2) That the personal aide to Representative Gould
 13 shall be paid a salary of \$800 per month;

14 (3) That the chief clerk of the house, secretary of
 15 the senate and sergeants at arms shall develop job
 16 descriptions for the positions listed which shall contain
 17 the minimum qualifications for each position. The
 18 descriptions shall be approved by the respective legislative
 19 administration committees;

20 (4) That the grades, steps and salaries authorized
 21 thereto are those contained in the fiscal year 1977 pay
 22 schedule approved by the 1975 legislature in House Joint
 23 Resolution 37;

24 (5) That all positions classified below grade 17 shall
 25 receive compensation for time worked beyond 40 hours per

1 week at the rate of time and a half. Such overtime shall be
 2 approved by the respective legislative administration
 3 committees or their designated representatives before the
 4 overtime is worked;

5 (6) That positions classified at grade 17 and above
 6 shall receive a salary for 40 hours per week regardless of
 7 the number of hours worked;

8 (7) That the respective legislative administration
 9 committees shall determine the appropriate step within the
 10 classified grade for each employee based on previous
 11 experience;

12 (8) That no additional benefits such as sick pay,
 13 vacation pay, state retirement contribution, state health
 14 insurance contribution or longevity allowances are
 15 authorized;

16 (9) That the distinction between researcher I and II
 17 is that the higher position requires a college degree and
 18 one year of research experience;

19 (10) That the chaplains shall be paid for two hours per
 20 legislative day served.

 12 A GUIDE, the appropriate step-within-the-classified-grade
 13 COMPENSATION for each employee based on previous experience;

14 (8) That no additional benefits such as sick pay,
 15 vacation pay, state retirement contribution, state health
 16 insurance contribution or longevity allowances are
 17 authorized;

18 (9) That the distinction between researcher I and II
 19 is that the higher position requires a college degree and
 20 one year of research experience;

21 (10) That the chaplains shall be paid for two hours per
 22 legislative day served.
