 4 A JOINT RESOLUTION OF THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF
 5 REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MONTANA URGING THE UNITED
 6 STATES CONGRESS TO REPEAL PUBLIC LAW 93-641, THE NATIONAL
 7 HEALTH PLANNING AND RESOURCES DEVELOPMENT ACT OF 1974.

 9 WHEREAS, Public Law 93-641 promotes duplication of
 10 effort for health planning in Montana;

11 WHEREAS, Public Law 93-641 requires duplication of
 12 effort for review of institutional health services in
 13 Montana;

14 WHEREAS, Public Law 93-641 gives a private health
 15 systems agency control of federal health funds granted to
 16 the State of Montana;

17 WHEREAS, this authority may be used to allocate such
 18 funds contrary to or in conflict with the allocations set by
 19 the elected representatives of the State of Montana.

 21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE
 22 OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

23 That the United States Congress is requested to
 24 consider the repeal of The National Health Planning and
 25 Resources Development Act of 1974, Public Law 93-641.

INTRODUCED BILL

1 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Secretary of State
 2 shall send copies of the resolution to Montana's
 3 Congressional Delegation.
