 6 The committee shall review the laws for the purpose of
 7 proposing amendments which promote efficiency, economy, and
 8 protection to the livestock industry. The chairman of the
 9 Board of Livestock shall chair the committee which shall
 10 serve without pay or remuneration for travel expenses. The
 11 committee may appoint subcommittees to assist in this
 12 review, which shall also serve without pay or remuneration
 13 for travel expenses.

 16 assistance to the committee.

A JOINT RESOLUTION OF THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MONTANA REQUESTING THE APPOINTMENT OF A COMMITTEE OF LIVESTOCK INDUSTRY PEOPLE TO MAKE AN INTERIM STUDY OF LAWS AFFECTING THE MOVEMENT AND MARKETING OF LIVESTOCK AND TO MAKE RECOMMENDATIONS FOR CHANGE TO THE 46TH SESSION OF THE LEGISLATURE.

WHEREAS, the production and marketing of livestock is a major Montana industry; and

WHEREAS, the laws governing the livestock industry have been, in the main, formulated many years ago; and

WHEREAS, there have been significant changes in the manner in which livestock are moved and marketed since the inception of these laws.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

That the Governor be requested to appoint a seven-person ~~10-PERSON~~ committee consisting of the chairman of the Board of Livestock, a licensed Montana livestock dealer, an owner or operator of a Montana Livestock Auction Market, an experienced employee of the Department of

Livestock, and ~~three~~ SIX other individuals who are livestock producers OR DIRECTLY CONNECTED WITH LIVESTOCK ORIENTED STATE ORGANIZATIONS OR ASSOCIATIONS, including at least one legislator, to serve as a committee to review all of the laws of Montana affecting the movement or marketing of livestock and to make recommendations to the 46th session of the legislature for the changes in the laws. The committee shall review the laws for the purpose of proposing amendments which promote efficiency, economy, and protection to the livestock industry. The chairman of the Board of Livestock shall chair the committee which shall serve without pay or remuneration for travel expenses. The committee may appoint subcommittees to assist in this review, which shall also serve without pay or remuneration for travel expenses.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Department of Livestock be requested to provide all necessary staff assistance to the committee.
