 4 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT AMENDING SECTION
 5 82A-212, R.C.M. 1947, TO CHANGE THE COMPOSITION OF THE
 6 TEACHERS' RETIREMENT BOARD."

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 8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

9 Section 1. Section 82A-212, R.C.M. 1947, is amended to
 10 read as follows:

11 "82A-212. Teachers' retirement board -- composition --
 12 terms -- allocated. (1) There is a teachers' retirement
 13 board.

14 (2) The board consists of ~~five--(5)~~ seven members
 15 appointed by the governor. The members are:

16 (a) ~~the~~ the superintendent of public instruction;

17 (b) ~~two--(2)~~ two persons appointed from the teaching
 18 profession who are members of the retirement system;

19 (c) ~~one retired teacher who is receiving a retirement~~
 20 ~~allowance from the teachers' retirement system of Montana;~~

21 (c)(d) ~~two--(2)~~ three persons appointed as
 22 representatives of the public.

23 (3) Each appointed member of the board shall serve a
 24 term of ~~four--(4)~~ years. Each appointed member shall take and
 25 subscribe to the oath prescribed by section 3 of article III

1 of the constitution of the state. The oath shall be filed
 2 in the office of the secretary of state.

3 (4) The board is allocated to the department for
 4 administrative purposes only as prescribed in section
 5 82A-108. However, the board may hire its own personnel, and
 6 section 82A-108(2)(d) does not apply."

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
