 4 A JOINT RESOLUTION OF THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF
 5 REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MONTANA REQUESTING THE
 6 COMMITTEE ON PRIORITIES TO ASSIGN THE APPROPRIATE STANDING
 7 COMMITTEES TO STUDY THE LAWS RELATING TO COMMUNITY COLLEGE
 8 DISTRICTS FOR THE PURPOSE OF GENERALLY CLARIFYING, UPDATING,
 9 SUPPLEMENTING, AND REVISING SUCH LAWS.

 11 WHEREAS, in 1971 the Legislature transferred
 12 supervision of the community college districts to the Board
 13 of Regents; and

14 WHEREAS, such transfer was not accompanied by enactment
 15 of an adequately comprehensive body of law dealing with
 16 community college districts; and

17 WHEREAS, there is no clearly applicable and adequately
 18 comprehensive body of law relating to powers and duties of
 19 community college district trustees, the relationship
 20 between the trustees and the Board of Regents, the
 21 relationship between the trustees and local government
 22 officers, and budgeting and financial administration
 23 procedures for community college districts; and

24 WHEREAS, a legislative study of the community college
 25 district laws, which would make recommendations for the

1 general clarification, updating, supplementation, and
 2 revision of such laws, would be useful to the Legislature
 3 and the people of Montana.

 5 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE
 6 OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

7 That the Committee on Priorities is requested to assign
 8 the appropriate standing committee to study the statutory
 9 provisions governing community college districts, to prepare
 10 recommendations for the general clarification, updating,
 11 supplementation, and revision of such provisions, and to
 12 report its findings and recommendations to the regular
 13 session of the 46th Legislature.
