A JOINT RESOLUTION OF THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MONTANA URGING THE RAISING OF THE FEDERAL LOAN PRICE OF WHEAT TO \$3.50 PER BUSHEL UNDER CERTAIN CONDITIONS.

WHEREAS, the present federal loan price for wheat is lower than the cost of producing the wheat; and

WHEREAS, over-production has created the present surplus of wheat, with the consequent depression of wheat prices.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

That the United States Secretary of Agriculture be urged to adopt a federal loan price of \$3.50 per bushel for wheat raised during 1976 and 1977, provided:

- (1) that the producer, to be eligible, must take out of production or replant to rangeland grasses (excluding grasses used for the production of hay) at least 10% of all land used for the production of wheat, barley, or corn in 1976;
- (2) that persons not taking 10% of their land out of

the production of the above crops shall receive the benefit of the present federal loan price of \$2.25.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that copies of this resolution be sent by the Secretary of State to President Jimmy Carter, Secretary of Agriculture Bob Bergland, Montana's Congressional Delegation, and Governor Thomas L. Judge.
