Masks, gloves and sanitizer are available, and courtrooms will be frequently sanitized. **Face coverings are required unless medical documentation of hardship is approved by the presiding judge**. The CDC has indicated that masks can assist in stopping the transmission of COVID-19 and may be helpful in slowing the spread of the illness.
