MASTER'S REPORT

The above-captioned claims appeared in the Preliminary Decree for the Musselshell River above Roundup (Basin 40A) issued on June 7, 2017. The claims did

not receive objections, counterobjections, or notices of intent to appear but did receive issue remarks during the DNRC's claims reexamination. Issue remarks are notations identifying potential legal or factual issues with water rights and the Water Court is required to resolve these potential issues.

FINDINGS OF FACT

40A 198183-00

- 1. Claim 40A 198183-00 is owned by J Bruce Glennie and Erin Glennie. The claim appeared in the Basin 40A Preliminary Decree as a stock claim for an onstream reservoir on Timber Creek in the SWSWNW of Section 15, T9N, R17E, Wheatland County.
 - The claim received the following issue remark:
 THE POINT OF DIVERSION, RESERVOIR RECORD, AND PLACE OF USE ARE IN QUESTION. THERE DOES NOT APPEAR TO BE A RESERVOIR AT THE CLAIMED LOCATION.
- 3. The DNRC examiner who reviewed claim 40A 198183-00 and placed the issue remark on the claim made the following note:

4. Claimants filed a statement and aerial photograph confirming there is in fact a small dam and reservoir in the SWSWNW of Section 15, T9N, R17E.

40A 202010-00

- 5. Claim 40A 202010-00 is owned by J Bruce Glennie, Erin Glennie, Shane Harman, Monte Harman, and Julie Thorson. The claim is a stock claim for an onstream reservoir on an unnamed tributary of Galloway Creek.
- 6. The location of the reservoir was originally claimed as being in the SWSWNE of Section 35, T11N, R17E, Wheatland County. During the DNRC's review, the point of diversion and reservoir legal land description were modified as follows:

- 7. The claim received an issue remark stating that the place of use should also be corrected. If stock historically took water directly from the claimed reservoir, the legal land description for the point of diversion and place of use should match.
- 8. Claimants filed a statement agreeing with the DNRC's proposed correction the place of use.

40A 203647-00

- 9. Claim 40A 203647-00 is owned by J Bruce Glennie and Erin Glennie. The claim appeared in the Basin 40A Preliminary Decree as a flood irrigation claim that diverts water via a headgate in the NWNESE of Section 2, T8N, R18E, Wheatland County.
 - 10. The claim received the following issue remark:

THE MEANS OF DIVERSION APPEARS TO BE INCORRECT. THE MEANS OF DIVERSION APPEARS TO BE A DAM.

11. Claimants filed a statement agreeing with the DNRC's proposed correction the means of diversion.

40A 204451-00

- 12. Claim 40A 204451-00 is owned by J Bruce Glennie and T Neil Glennie. The claim appeared in the Basin 40A Preliminary Decree as a stock claim from Timber Creek in the SWSENW of Section 1, T10N, R17E, Wheatland County.
 - 13. The claim received the following issue remark:

THE CLAIMED POINT OF DIVERSION MAY BE INCORRECT. THE LOCATION OF THE DIVERSION CANNOT BE IDENTIFIED FROM AVAILABLE DATA. DNRC CANNOT DETERMINE IF THE DIVERSION IS FROM TIMBER CREEK OR AN UNNAMED TRIBUTARY OF TIMBER CREEK.

14. Claimants filed a statement and map showing the point of diversion being in the SESENW of Section 1, T10N, R17E.

Notice-Type Issue Remarks

15. The claims received notice-type issue remarks as follows:

THE CLAIMANT DID NOT IDENTIFY THE PERIOD OF DIVERSION FOR THIS RIGHT. A PERIOD OF DIVERSION HAS BEEN ADDED TO MATCH THE PERIOD OF USE. IF NO OBJECTIONS ARE RECEIVED TO THE PERIOD OF DIVERSION OR PERIOD OF USE, THOSE ELEMENTS WILL BE DECREED AS SHOWN ON THIS ABSTRACT AND THIS ISSUE REMARK WILL BE REMOVED FROM THIS CLAIM.

RESERVOIR RECORD WAS MODIFIED AS A RESULT OF DNRC REVIEW UNDER MONTANA WATER COURT REEXAMINATION ORDERS. IF NO OBJECTIONS ARE FILED TO THIS CLAIM, THESE ELEMENTS WILL REMAIN AS THEY APPEAR ON THIS ABSTRACT AND THE REMARK WILL BE REMOVED FROM THE CLAIM.

16. The issue remarks identify elements modified as a result of DNRC review pursuant to Montana Water Court reexamination orders. The remarks indicate that if no objections are filed, the elements of the claim will remain as they appear on the abstract and the remarks will be removed. None of the claims received objections.

PRINCIPLES OF LAW

- 1. A properly filed Statement of Claim for an existing water right is prima facie proof of its content. Section 85-2-227, MCA; Rule 10, W.R.Adj.R.
- 2. Prima facie proof may be contradicted and overcome by a preponderance of the evidence. Rule 19, W.R.Adj.R.
- 3. A preponderance of the evidence is evidence that shows a fact is "more probable than not." *Hohenlohe v. State*, 2010 MT 203, ¶ 33, 357 Mont. 438, 240 P.3d 628.
- 4. If prima facie status is overcome, the burden shifts back to the claimant to demonstrate historical use. *79 Ranch v. Pitsch*, 204 Mont. 426, 432-33, 666 P.2d 215, 218 (1983).
- 5. Section 85-2-248(2), MCA, requires that the Water Court resolve all issue remarks that are not resolved through the objection process. *See also* Rule 7, W.R.Adj.R.
- 6. The Water Court may use information submitted by the DNRC, the Statement of Claim, and any other data obtained by the Court to evaluate a water right. Sections 85-2-227, -231(2), MCA.
- 7. When resolving issue remarks, the Water Court must weigh the information resulting in the issue remark and the issue remark against the claimed water right. Section 85-2-247(2), MCA. The factual evidence on which an issue remark is based must meet

the preponderance of evidence standard before the prima facie status of a claim is overcome. 43Q 200996-00 et al., Order Establishing Volume and Order Closing Case, at 18, June 8, 2015.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

40A 198183-00

1. The reservoir issue remark does not overcome the prima facie status of claim 40A 198183-00. Claimants provided evidence showing the point of diversion was claimed correctly. The claim elements should remain as they appeared in the Basin 40A Preliminary Decree, and the issue remark should be removed from the claim abstract.

40A 202010-00

2. The place of use issue remark overcomes the prima facie status of claim 40A 202010-00. The place of use should be corrected as described in Finding of Fact No. 6. This correction resolves the place of use issue remark, and the remark should be removed from the claim abstract.

40A 203647-00

3. The means of diversion issue remark overcomes the prima facie status of claim 40A 203647-00. The means of diversion should be corrected to a dam. This correction resolves the means of diversion issue remark, and the remark should be removed from the claim abstract.

40A 204451-00

4. The point of diversion issue remark overcomes the prima facie status of claim 40A 204451-00. Claimants provided evidence showing the point of diversion is in the SESENW of Section 1, T10N, R17E. The point of diversion should be corrected accordingly. This correction resolves the point of diversion issue remark, and the remark should be removed from the claim abstract.

Notice-Type Issue Remark

5. Each remark in Finding of Fact No. 15 provides notice of the changes made after completion of the Temporary Preliminary Decree proceedings and prior to issuance of the Preliminary Decree. The remarks do not raise unresolved issues that need to be

addressed. No proceedings are required to resolve the remarks; the remarks should be removed from the abstracts.

RECOMMENDATIONS

Based on the foregoing Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, this Master recommends that the Court adopt the changes as outlined above.

A post decree abstract of each water right claim reflecting the recommended changes is attached to this Report.
