FINDINGS OF FACT


- 1. Thomas J. Schaetz is the record owner of stock claim 40E 113850-00.
- 2. Claim 40E 113850-00 was decreed with DNRC issue remarks:

SOURCE NAME WAS MODIFIED AS A RESULT OF DNRC REVIEW UNDER MONTANA WATER COURT REEXAMINATION ORDERS. IF NO OBJECTIONS ARE FILED TO THIS CLAIM, THESE ELEMENTS WILL REMAIN AS THEY APPEAR ON THIS ABSTRACT AND THE REMARK WILL BE REMOVED FROM THE CLAIM

EXISTENCE OF THE CLAIMED RESERVOIR CANNOT BE CONFIRMED WITH AVAILABLE DATA.

The source issue remark is a notice-type remark that does not require further attention.

- 3. The Claimant was ordered to meet with the DNRC to address the reservoir issue remark decreed on the claim.
- 3. On June 17, 2022, DNRC Water Resource Pam Weinmeister filed a Memorandum stating she spoke with Claimant Thomas J. Schaetz regarding the claim. Ms. Weinmeister stated that she reviewed the Supreme Court Examination Rules, maps, and used a Motion to Amend submitted by Thomas J. Schaetz as data sources for the Memorandum. A Motion to Amend claim 40E 113850-00 was submitted with the Memorandum. A copy of the Memorandum and the Motion to Amend is attached to this Report.
- 4. Based on the recommendations made by Ms. Weinmeister and consistent with the Motion to Amend Claim 40E 113850-00, the following changes should be made:



PRINCIPLES AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. A properly filed Statement of Claim for an existing water right is prima facie proof of its content. Section 85-2-227, MCA. This prima facie validity may be overcome by evidence showing that one or more elements of the claim are incorrect. This standard of proof applies to objectors or claimants objecting to their own water right claims. Rule 19, W.R.Adj.R., *Nelson v. Brooks*, 2014 MT 120; 375 Mont.86, 95; 329 P.3d 558, 564.
- 2. The Water Court must address all issue remarks that appear on a claim. Section 85-2-248, MCA.
- 3. The proposed corrections to source and place of use legal land descriptions do not have a reasonable potential to adversely affect other water users and therefore do not require further notice as provided for in Section 85-2-233(6), MCA. The changes do not constitute expansions of the elements of the claims, they merely reflect corrections to the paper water rights. The use of the water right on the ground has not changed.
- 4. The source name remark is a notice-type remark. As no objections were filed, no further proceedings are required.

RECOMMENDATIONS

- Claim 40E 113850-00 should be changed as shown in Finding of Fact No.
 - 2. The issue remarks should be removed from claim 40E 113850-00.

INTRODUCTION:

Pursuant to the May 2, 2022 Order from the Montana Water Court, Thomas J Schaetz was ordered to confer with the Glasgow Regional Office of the Department of Natural Resources & Conservation (DNRC) the reservoir issue remark. He was given until May 16, 2022 to contact the Glasgow Regional Office.

MATERIALS REVIEWED

Information in the claim files, Supreme Court Claim Examination rules, conversation with Thomas Schaetz, USDA Aerial photo 179-28 dated 9/17/1979, topographical maps Fortyfour Coulee & Flowing Well, Verified Motion to Amend Water Right Claim received 5/27/2022, and reservoir data received 5/27/2022 served as the primary data sources for this memorandum.

DISCUSSION 40E 113850-00

This is a stock claim for a dam located on Crooked Creek. The decreed point of diversion is NESENE Sec. 26 Twp. 19N Rge. 43E McCone County.

On May 9, 2022, Thomas Schaetz contacted the Glasgow Regional Office to discuss the following issue remark.

R100 EXISTENCE OF THE CLAIMED RESERVOIR CANNOT BE CONFIRMED WITH AVAILABLE DATA.

During the conversation, Thomas Schaetz explained there is only one reservoir located in Sec. 26 Twp. 19N Rge. 43E. A reservoir can be seen on USDA Aerial photo 179-28 dated 9/17/1979 (Exhibit 1). The location of this reservoir does not match the decreed point of diversion, reservoir information, or place of use.

It was discussed that if this reservoir is the one that was built in 1959, the point of diversion, reservoir information, and the place of use could be amended to reflect the actual historic location. It was further discussed the source would need to be amended if the point of diversion, reservoir information, and the place of use were amended. According to topographical maps Fortyfour Coulee and Flowing Well, the correct source would be Unnamed tributary of Crooked Creek (Exhibit 2).

A Verified Motion to Amend Water Right Claim and copy of USDA Aerial photo were mailed to Thomas Schaetz to review. Estimated reservoir information was sent to Mr. Schaetz.

- The surface area was measured at 2.81 acres
- Estimated maximum depth of 10 feet
- Estimated dam height of 13 feet.
- Estimated capacity of 11.24 Acre-Feet.

Mr. Schaetz was asked to provide the actual dam height and maximum depth of water. The formula to compute the capacity of the reservoir was supplied in the letter to calculate the capacity.

Mr. Schaetz submitted the Verified Motion to Amend Water Right on 5/27/2022 amending the source, point of diversion, reservoir information, and place of use to reflect the actual historic location of the reservoir. Information regarding the dam height and maximum depth of water were provided (See Exhibit 3).





As we discussed on May 9, 2022, the purpose of the order from the Water Court is to resolve the reservoir issue remark.

EXISTENCE OF THE CLAIMED RESERVOIR CANNOT BE CONFIRMED WITH AVAILABLE DATA.

You explained there is only one reservoir in Sec. 26 Twp. 19N Rge. 43E. Looking at the 1979 USDA Aerial photo, it appears the reservoir is located in the SWNE Sec. 26 Twp. 19N Rge. 43E. If this is the reservoir that was constructed in July of 1959, the point of diversion, reservoir information, source, and place of use will need to be amended.

Enclosed is a Verified Motion to Amend Water Right Claim reflecting the amended elements, so the water right reflects the actual historic information about this reservoir. If you agree with the information on the verified motion to amend, please sign the form, and return to the Glasgow Water Resources Regional Office.

If you don't agree with the information on the amendment form, enclosed is a blank Verified Motion to Amend Water Right Claim form for you to complete.

I measured the surface area of the reservoir at 2.81 acres. I estimated the depth of the reservoir at 10 feet. The estimated dam height is 13 feet. The estimated capacity would be 11.24 acre-feet.
