MASTER'S REPORT

The above-captioned claims appeared in the Preliminary Decree for the Box Elder Creek (Basin 39E) dated February 5, 2020. The claims received issue remarks resulting from the Department of Natural Resources and Conservation's (DNRC) review in preparation of the Preliminary Decree. These issue remarks identify potential legal or factual issues with the water right. The Water Court consolidated the claims into Water Court Case 39E-0014-R-2021 to address the objections and issue remarks.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. The Claimants filed several responses with the Court providing information and evidence to address the remarks. Shane Peabody filed an affidavit on December 24, 2021, providing additional evidence. Mr. Peabody signed the 2019 statements of claim for claims 39E 30145161, 39E 30145166, 39E 30145168, and 39E 30145170, and has lived on the property on which these claims are used for over sixty years. Claim 39E 35449-00:
- 2. Claim 39E 35449-00 is claim to stock drinking from a reservoir in the NESWNE of Section 30, T1S, R58E. Its means of diversion is listed as "dam." The claim received the following issue remarks raising legal or factual issues with the claim:

THE WATER RIGHTS LISTED FOLLOWING THIS STATEMENT APPEAR TO BE DUPLICATE FILINGS. IT APPEARS ONLY ONE WATER RIGHT IS INVOLVED. 30145161 35449-00

- 3. The Claimants' October 4, 2021 Response clarifies that claims 39E 30145161 and 39E 35449-00 are not duplicate filings because 39E 35449-00, which is diverted by a dam, represents the reservoir in the NESWNE of Section 30, while 39E 30145161 claims livestock drinking directly from the source. The Claimants submitted a Verified Motion to Amend signed by Shane and Barbara Peabody, correcting the points of diversion and places of use of claim 39E 30145161 to reflect the portions of the source above and below the reservoir where livestock drink.
- 4. The Claimants request the following modification to reflect that water for this onstream reservoir is impounded whenever water is flowing in the source:

Period of Diversion: April 1-December 31 January 1-December 31

5. The claim also received following issue remark that serves only to provide notice of DNRC modifications to the claim (Notice Only Remark)

Claim 39E 174707-00

6. Claim 39E 174707-00 is a claim for stock drinking from Fresh Water Draw. It appeared in the Preliminary Decree with the following Notice Only Remarks:

THE CLAIMANT DID NOT IDENTIFY THE PERIOD OF DIVERSION FOR THIS RIGHT. A PERIOD OF DIVERSION HAS BEEN ADDED TO MATCH THE PERIOD OF USE. IF NO OBJECTIONS ARE RECEIVED TO THE PERIOD OF DIVERSION OR PERIOD OF USE, THOSE ELEMENTS WILL BE DECREED AS SHOWN ON THIS ABSTRACT AND THIS ISSUE REMARK WILL BE REMOVED FROM THIS CLAIM.

RESERVOIR RECORD AND MEANS OF DIVERSION WERE MODIFIED AS A RESULT OF DNRC REVIEW UNDER MONTANA WATER COURT REEXAMINATION ORDERS. IF NO OBJECTIONS ARE FILED TO THIS CLAIM, THESE ELEMENTS WILL REMAIN AS THEY APPEAR ON THIS ABSTRACT AND THE REMARK WILL BE REMOVED FROM THE CLAIM.

Claim 39E 174708-00:

7. Claim 39E 174708-00 is a claim for stock drinking from two onstream reservoirs on an unnamed tributary of Buffalo Creek in the SWNESW of Section 28, T1S and the SE of Section 28, respectively. It appeared in the Preliminary Decree with the following issue remark:

THE WATER RIGHTS LISTED FOLLOWING THIS STATEMENT APPEAR TO BE DUPLICATE FILINGS. IT APPEARS ONLY ONE WATER RIGHT IS INVOLVED. 174708-00 30145166

8. The Claimants' October 4, 2021 Response clarifies that claims 39E 174708-00 and 39E 30145166 are not duplicate filings because 39E 174708-00, which is diverted with a dam, represents the reservoirs on the source, while 39E 30145166 claimed livestock drinking directly from the source above and below the reservoirs. These claims have different places of use and are not duplicate claims. The Claimants submitted a Verified Motion to Amend claim 39E 30145166 to more accurately reflect where livestock drink along the source.

9. Claim 39E 174708-00 also received the following Notice Only Remarks:

THE CLAIMANT DID NOT IDENTIFY THE PERIOD OF DIVERSION FOR THIS RIGHT. A PERIOD OF DIVERSION HAS BEEN ADDED TO MATCH THE PERIOD OF USE. IF NO OBJECTIONS ARE RECEIVED TO THE PERIOD OF DIVERSION OR PERIOD OF USE, THOSE ELEMENTS WILL BE DECREED AS SHOWN ON THIS ABSTRACT AND THIS ISSUE REMARK WILL BE REMOVED FROM THIS CLAIM.

Claim 39E 174709-00:

10. Claim 39E 174709-00 appeared in the Preliminary Decree with the following issue remarks raising legal or factual issues with the claim:

THE WATER RIGHTS LISTED FOLLOWING THIS STATEMENT APPEAR TO BE DUPLICATE FILINGS. IT APPEARS ONLY ONE WATER RIGHT IS INVOLVED. 174709-00 30145168

ON NOVEMBER 29, 1989 THE MONTANA DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES AND CONSERVATION FILED A MEMORANDUM STATING THAT THE SOURCE NAME IS ERRONEOUS. THIS WILL BE HEARD AFTER PROPER NOTICE ON THE NEXT OBJECTION LIST

THE CLAIMED VOLUME APPEARS TO BE EXCESSIVE FOR THE CLAIMED PURPOSE. THE CLAIMED VOLUME EQUALS 8.28 TIMES THE CAPACITY OF THE RESERVOIR.

11. A January 4, 2022 Verified Motion to Amend signed by the Peabodys, requests the following modifications to this claim to address the issue remarks:

onstream reservoir.

- 12. The source name modification is supported by a November 24, 1989 memorandum from Walter Rolf, Field Manager at the Miles City Field Office of the DNRC. The modifications to the flow rate, volume, and points of diversion reflect that this is primarily a direct flow irrigation right. The claim relies primarily on water that flows through these two onstream reservoirs, rather than water stored in the reservoirs. This explanation is consistent with the Aril 23, 1982 Statement of Claim for this right, which does not mention the reservoirs, but instead indicates flood and dike irrigation from an unnamed tributary of Buffalo Creek with a maximum flow rate of 20 CFS. The reservoir record modification is supported by aerial photos, and the Period of diversion modification reflects that water for these onstream reservoirs is impounded whenever water is flowing in the source.
- 13. The duplicate claim issue remark appears to have been placed on this claim in error because the listed claims are for different purposes. 39E 174709-00 is for irrigation while claim 39E 30145168 is for stock. It appears these claims are multiple uses of the same water right filed on separate claim forms, as was common practice.
 - 14. The claim also received the following Notice Only Remarks.

THE CLAIMANT DID NOT IDENTIFY THE PERIOD OF DIVERSION FOR THIS RIGHT. A PERIOD OF DIVERSION HAS BEEN ADDED TO MATCH THE PERIOD OF USE. IF NO OBJECTIONS ARE RECEIVED TO THE PERIOD OF DIVERSION OR PERIOD OF USE, THOSE ELEMENTS WILL BE DECREED AS SHOWN ON THIS ABSTRACT AND THIS ISSUE REMARK WILL BE REMOVED FROM THIS CLAIM.

Claim 39E 174710-00:

15. Claim 39E 174710-00 is a water spreading irrigation claim to water from Fresh Water Draw. It appeared in the Preliminary Decree with the following issue remark raising legal or factual issues:

THE CLAIMED VOLUME APPEARS TO BE EXCESSIVE FOR THE CLAIMED PURPOSE. THE CLAIMED VOLUME EQUALS 7.13 TIMES THE CAPACITY OF THE RESERVOIR.

16. The volume issue remark was placed on this claim because the size of the reservoir appears inadequate to store and release the claimed volume. However, this is a

water spreading claim, not a typical storage claim. Water spreading claims divert water based on availability instead of demand. Available water is diverted regardless of the amount of water stored in the reservoir, and therefore, the reservoir size does not indicate the volume of the claim is excessive.

17. The Claimants request the following modifications to the claim:

Period of Diversion: March 1 to December 1 January 1 to December 31 Add Informational Remark:

The source is also known as Unnamed Tributary, Buffalo Creek.

- 18. The period of diversion modification reflects that this water spreading claim with an onstream reservoir diverts water whenever water is flowing in the source.

APPLICABLE LAW

1. A properly filed Statement of Claim for Existing Water Right is prima facie proof of its content. § 85-2-227, MCA. This prima facie proof may be contradicted and overcome by other evidence that proves, by a preponderance of the evidence, that the elements of the claim do not accurately reflect the beneficial use of the water right as it

existed prior to July 1, 1973. This is the burden of proof for every assertion that a claim is incorrect. Rule 19, W.R.Adj.R.

- 2. Section 85-2-248(2), MCA, requires that the Water Court resolve all issue remarks that are not resolved through the objection process. *See also* Rule 7, W.R.Adj.R.
- 3. When resolving issue remarks, the Water Court must weigh the information resulting in the issue remark and the issue remark against the claimed water right. Section 85-2-247(2), MCA. The factual evidence on which an issue remark is based must meet the preponderance of evidence standard before the prima facie status of a claim is overcome. 43Q 200996-00 et al., Order Establishing Volume and Order Closing Case, at 18, June 8, 2015
- 4. In addition to the specific water right elements that must be included in a final decree, the Water Court also may include "any other information necessary to fully define the nature and extent of the right." § 85-2-234(6)(i), MCA. This information typically takes the form of an "information remark." The purpose of an information remark is to "provide facts regarding prior use of a right that are critical to its administration in accord with historical use." In re Clark Fork Coal., Case 76G-A8, 2014 Mont. Water LEXIS 15, *10 (Oct. 29, 2014).

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The Findings of Fact above are supported by a preponderance of the evidence. The above-described modifications to periods of diversion to reflect that the onstream reservoirs divert water year-round are unlikely to adversely affect other water users and do not require additional notice under Section 85-2-248(2), MCA. The claims should be modified as described in Findings of Fact 4, 11, 17, 21, 24, 28, and 32, above.
- 2. The duplicate claim issue remarks on claims 39E 174709-00 and 39E 30145168, means of diversion remark on 39E 30145161, point of diversion issue remark on claim 39E 30145168, place of use issue remark on claim 39E 30145170, and volume issue remark on claim 39E 174710-00 fail to overcome the prima facie status of the claims. These remarks should be removed from the claims.
- 3. The modifications described above resolve the duplicate claim issue remarks on claims 39E 35449-00, 39E 174708-00, 39E 30145161, 39E 30145166, the

source name and volume issue remarks on claim 39E 174709-00, and the type of historical right remarks on claim 39E 30145158, 39E 30145166 and 39E 30145168. These remarks should be removed from the claims.

- 4. The filing fee issue remarks on claims 39E 30145158, 39E 30145161, 39E 30145166, 39E 30145168, 39E 30145170 are resolved and should be removed from the claims.
- 5. The Notice Only Remarks do not raise legal or factual issues for the Water Court to resolve. They have served their notice purpose and should be removed from the claims.
- 6. The informational remarks described in the Finding of Fact 11 and 17 above provides information to assist in the administration of the rights and should be added to claims 39R 174709 and 39E 174710-00.

RECOMMENDATIONS


Based on the foregoing Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, this Master recommends that the Court adopt the changes as outlined above.


