MASTER'S REPORT FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Claim 43P 2483-00 appeared in the Preliminary Decree for the Bighorn River, Below Greybull River (Basin 43P) with issue remarks. The Apsaalooke (Crow) Tribe and the United States of America (Bureau of Indian Affairs) ("BIA") filed Objections to the claim.

2. On August 6, 2018 the above captioned claim was consolidated into Case 43P-0246-P-2018.

3. On June 29, 2022, a Stipulation was filed with the Court. The Stipulation indicated that the Claimant and the Objectors had agreed to the modification of claim 43P 2483-00.

PRINCIPLES OF LAW

1. The Montana Water Court has the authority to determine the extent of all water rights in the state as they existed prior to July 1, 1973. *Fellows v. Saylor*, 2016 MT 45, ¶ 25, 382 Mont. 298, 367 P.3d 732; §§ 85-2-233, -102(12), MCA. The purpose of the Water Court is to adjudicate rights to the use of water as they existed on July 1, 1973. *In re Clark Fork River*, 254 Mont. 11, 17, 833 P.3d 1120 (Mont. 1992).

2. A properly filed Statement of Claim for Existing Water Right is prima facie proof of its content. § 85-2-227, MCA. This prima facie proof may be contradicted and overcome by other evidence that proves, by a preponderance of the evidence, that the elements of the claim do not accurately reflect the beneficial use of the water right as it existed prior to July 1, 1973. This is the burden of proof for every assertion that a claim is incorrect. Rule 19, W.R.Adj.R.

3. "The Water Court is not bound by settlement agreements. Any settlement reached by the parties is subject to review and approval by the Water Court." Rule 17(a), W.R.Adj.R; *In re Argabright*, 2014 Mont. Water LEXIS 9, 41I 265 (December 12, 2014).

4. Where a claimant agrees to reduce or limit an element of a claim, "the water court does not need to determine whether the burden of proof has been met." Rule 17(c), W.R.Adj.R. The Court may accept the requested reduction or limitation "without further presentation of evidence." Rule 17(c), W.R.Adj.R.

CONCLUSION OF LAW

1. The Stipulation conforms to applicable law. Claim 43P 2483-00 should be modified as discussed above.

RECOMMENDATION

1. Upon review of the record in this case, claim 43P 2483-00 should be modified as discussed.
