If you do not file a timely objection, the Water Court will conclude that you agree with the content of this Master's Report.

MASTER'S REPORT

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Claim 41G 199026-00 is an irrigation claim from South Willow Creek. It received a Department of Natural Resources (DNRC) issue remark concerning the place of use.

2. In the Preliminary Decree, the owners of claim 41G 199026-00 were identified as Kathryn L. Simpson 2006 Revocable Trust and Michelle J. Walker. To resolve the place of use issue remark on claim 41G 199026-00, the claimants were required to meet with the DNRC in an informal attempt to resolve the issue remark.

3. On March 7, 2023, the DNRC filed a memorandum with recommendations for issue remark resolution. The memo indicates that the claimants contacted the DNRC and discussed the issue remark.


4. Claim 41G 199026-00 identifies a 100.00-acre place of use. It received an issue remark stating:

THIS CLAIM PRESENTS ISSUES OF FACT AND LAW THAT MAY BE ADDRESSED AT THE OBJECTION STAGE. IT APPEARS THAT 85.00 ACRES ARE ACTUALLY IRRIGATED AND PROBLEMS COULD EXIST WITH FLOW RATE AND VOLUME.

In its memo, the DNRC recommends the place of use be reduced from 100 acres to 95 acres with the following legal land description:

The DNRC also indicates that a portion of the place of use appears to be owned by Marshall Mellot.



5. Marshall Mellot was provided notice of potential ownership in claim 41G 199026-00. An ownership update was processed on May 1, 2023 adding Mellot as an owner of claim 41G 199026-00.

6. A show cause order was issued for any of the claimants to comment on the DNRC's recommendation to reduce the place of use from 100 acres to 95 acres. The order stated that if nothing was filed by the deadline, the court would conclude that the DNRC's recommendations should be accepted. Nothing was filed by the deadline. Claim 41G 199026-00 should be reduced from 100 acres to 95 acres.

7. Claim 41G 199026-00 received two additional issue remarks:

POINT OF DIVERSION AND DITCH NAME WERE MODIFIED AS A RESULT OF DNRC REVIEW UNDER MONTANA WATER COURT REEXAMINATION ORDERS. IF NO OBJECTIONS ARE FILED TO THIS CLAIM, THESE ELEMENTS WILL REMAIN AS THEY APPEAR ON THIS ABSTRACT AND THE REMARK WILL BE REMOVED FROM THE CLAIM.

THE SOURCE NAME HAS BEEN CHANGED TO BE CONSISTENT WITH THE 1988 UNITED STATES GEOLOGICAL SURVEY QUADRANGLE FOR THIS AREA. SOURCE NAME OF THIS CLAIM HAS BEEN CHANGED FROM WILLOW CREEK TO SOUTH WILLOW CREEK. BECAUSE OF INCONSISTENT SOURCE NAMES APPEARING IN THE TEMPORARY PRELIMINARY DECREE DURING THE OBJECTION PERIOD, ANY WATER USER WHOSE RIGHTS HAVE BEEN ADVERSELY AFFECTED BY THIS CHANGE MAY PETITION THE APPROPRIATE COURT FOR RELIEF OR MAY FILE AN OBJECTION AT THE PRELIMINARY DECREE.

These remarks are considered "notice" issue remarks. Their purpose is to provide notice of changes made to the claim since the adjudication of the Temporary Preliminary Decree. The remarks do not raise issues that require further proceedings. The notice issue remarks should be removed from the claim.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. A properly filed claim of an existing right or an amended claim of existing right is prima facie proof of its content. § 85-2-227, MCA. This prima facie proof may be contradicted and overcome by other evidence that proves, by a preponderance of the evidence, that the elements of the claim do not accurately reflect the beneficial use of the water right as it existed prior to July 1, 1973. This is the burden of proof for every assertion that a claim is incorrect. Rule 19, W.R.Adj.R.

2. Section 85-2-248(2), MCA requires the Water Court to resolve all issue remarks that are not resolved through the objection process. The Montana Water Court has the authority to resolve issue remarks when the claim file and information available to the Court provide a sufficient basis to do so. § 85-2-248(3), MCA.

3. The information and recommendation provided by the DNRC is sufficient to resolve the place of use issue remark appearing on claim 41G 199026-00-00. The notice issue remarks do not overcome the prima facie status of the claim and should be considered resolved.

RECOMMENDATIONS

1. The issue remarks should be removed from claim 41G 199026-00.

A Post Decree Abstract of Water Right Claim is served with the Report to confirm that the issue remarks have been removed from the claim abstract.
