MASTER'S REPORT

The claims in this case appeared in the Preliminary Decree for Basin 41H with Montana Department of Natural Resources and Conservation (DNRC) issue remarks questioning the point of diversion. The claims received objections from Claimant Blackwood Dry Creek LP ("Blackwood"). Blackwood filed a Proposed Corrections to Claims on July 24, 2023.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Blackwood submitted a Memorandum prepared by DMS Natural Resources, LLC as well as maps, aerial photographs, and excerpts from each claim's respective claims files to support its requested changes. The Memorandum also contains photographs of the claims from a site visit.
- 2. Claim 41H 126848-00 is a stock claim from an unnamed tributary of South Dry Creek. Blackwood requests the point of diversion and means of diversion be corrected as follows:

- 3. Blackwood also requests the place of use ID No. 3 for claim 41H 126848-00 be removed.
- 4. The requested modifications are based on the claim file map and historical aerial photographs as well as the claim's on-the-ground locations on Blackwood's property.

- 5. Claim 41H 126849-00 is a stock claim from a spring to an unnamed tributary of South Dry Creek. Blackwood requests corrections to the place of use as follows:
 - a. POU ID No. 1 should be refined from the NW to the <u>E2NW</u>, Section 19, Twp
 2S, Rge 5E, Gallatin County.
 - POU ID No. 2 should be added in the <u>SWNE</u>, <u>Section 19</u>, <u>Twp 2S</u>, <u>Rge 5E</u>,
 <u>Gallatin County</u>.
- 6. The requested modifications are based on the claim file map and historical aerial photographs as well as the claim's on-the-ground locations on Blackwood's property.
- 7. Claim 41H 126850-00 is a stock claim from South Dry Creek. Blackwood requests corrections to the point of diversion and place of use as follows:
 - a. The POD and Means of Diversion should be corrected to:

- 8. The requested modifications are based on the claim file map and discussion with the owner of Blackwood who states that stock have historically utilized both the natural channel of South Dry Creek as well as the South Dry Creek Ditches. The original statement of claim filing was submitted for stock use from South Dry Creek with POD and POU legal land descriptions of all of Section 19, T2S R5E. Means of diversion was claimed as "Direct." Stock use in ditches is not explicitly stated on the original statement of claim filing. However, the claimant identified three separate headgate PODs on the map enclosed with the original statement of claim filing.
- 9. Claim 41H 126852-00 is an irrigation claim from the waste and seepage of an unnamed tributary of South Dry Creek. Blackwood requests the following changes to the place of use:
 - a. POU ID No. 4 should be corrected and POU ID No. 5 should be added, as follows:

- 10. These changes to the place of use would increase the maximum acres irrigated to 560.
- 11. Blackwood requests these modifications because, based on the map provided with the original statement of claim, Gallatin County Water Resource Survey maps, and historical aerials, historical irrigation under 41H 126856-00 also included 8 acres in the SWNW, Lot 2, of Section 19, T2S R5E. However, the claimant appears to have inadvertently omitted this legal land description from the original statement of claim filing. Instead, the claimant appears to have inadvertently included the 8 acres of irrigation in the SWNW of Section 19 within the 80 acres of irrigation claimed in the E2NW of Section 19 on the original statement of claim form.
- 12. Claim 41H 126853-00 is an irrigation claim from South Dry Creek. Blackwood requests changes to the volume and place of use as follows:

a. The Volume should be removed from this claim and should be replaced with the following information remark:

THE TOTAL VOLUME OF THIS WATER RIGHT SHALL NOT EXCEED THE AMOUNT PUT TO HISTORICAL AND BENEFICIAL USE

- The Maximum Acres irrigated should be reduced from 240.00 to 191.00
 acres.
- c. POU should be corrected to:

- 13. Blackwood requests these modifications to resolve the issue remarks on this claim which state the claimed place of use and acres irrigated may be questionable and flow rate and volume may require modification based on resolution of acres irrigated remark.
- 14. During 2017 review, DNRC added the POU / acres irrigated issue remark listed above. The issue remark does not point to any specific information or aerials, and it is unclear if the issue remark was added based on 2017 review of aerial imagery or based on the prior comment in the claim file from the DNRC's original 1983 review. Based on the claim file map, historic aerial imagery, and the WRS maps, a total of 191 acres have been historically irrigated, and are currently irrigated, within the claimed legal land descriptions and area shown on the claim file map.
- 15. Blackwood states the claimant over-estimated the number of acres within the claimed POU on the original statement of claim filing. Additionally, the claimed POU includes acres throughout the SE of Section 19, T2S R5E, but the claimant inadvertently omitted the W2SE of Section 19, T2S R5E, from the claimed legal land descriptions. 41H 126853-00 should be decreed with a POU of 191 acres in the SE, E2NW, and W2NE of Section 19, T2S R5E.

- 16. Blackwood further requests a standard volume remark be used on claim 41H 126853-00 in lieu of a specified numerical volume as this is a direct-flow irrigation claim.
- 17. Claim 41H 126854-00 is an irrigation claim from South Dry Creek. Blackwood requests changes to the volume and place of use as follows:
 - a. The Volume should be removed from this claim and should be replaced with the following information remark:

THE TOTAL VOLUME OF THIS WATER RIGHT SHALL NOT EXCEED THE AMOUNT PUT TO HISTORICAL AND BENEFICIAL USE

- The Maximum Acres irrigated should be reduced from 266.00 to <u>242.00</u> acres.
- c. POU should be corrected to:

- 18. Blackwood requests these modifications to resolve the issue remarks on this claim which state the claimed place of use and acres irrigated may be questionable and flow rate and volume may require modification based on resolution of acres irrigated remark.
- 19. During 2017 review, DNRC added the POU / acres irrigated issue remark listed above. The issue remark does not point to any specific information or aerials, and it is unclear if the issue remark was added based on 2017 review of aerial imagery or based on the prior comment in the claim file from the DNRC's original 1983 review. Based on the claim file map, historic aerial imagery, and the WRS maps, a total of 242 acres have been historically irrigated, and are currently irrigated, within the claimed legal land descriptions and area shown on the claim file map.

- 20. The claimant over-estimated the number of acres within the claimed POU on the original statement of claim filing. Additionally, the claimed POU includes acres throughout the SW, W2SE, SWNE, and S2NW of Section 19, T2S R5E, but the claimant inadvertently omitted the S2NW and SWNE of Section 19, T2S R5E, from the claimed legal land descriptions. 41H 126854 00 should be decreed with a POU of 242 acres in the SW, W2SE, SWNE, and S2NW of Section 19, T2S R5E, and the E2SE of Section 24, T2S R4E.
- 21. Blackwood further requests a standard volume remark be used on claim 41H 126854-00 in lieu of a specified numerical volume as this is a direct-flow irrigation claim.
- 22. Claim 41H 126855-00 is an irrigation claim from an unnamed tributary of South Dry Creek. Blackwood requests changes to the flow rate and point of diversion as follows:
 - a. The Flow Rate for this claim should be corrected from 1.25 CFS to 2.5 CFS.
 - b. Additional POD ID Nos. 2 and 3 should be added as follows:

- 23. The requested modifications to the points of diversion are based on the claim file map and historical aerial photographs as well as the claim's on-the-ground locations on Blackwood's property.
- 24. To support the increase in flow rate to claim 41H 120855-00, Blackwood states Original statement of claim was filed with a flow rate of "50 plus" MI. To support the filing, the claimant provided three affidavits supporting the Blackwood Property's senior use of water from Foster Spring Creek, and a 1964 agreement regarding water use from Foster Spring Creek. According to the 1964 agreement, Foster Spring Creek flows

"approximately one hundred miner's inches of waters which can and is used for irrigation of the lands owned by the parties hereto."

- 25. The agreement also states that the predecessor of Blackwood Dry Creek LP, Edward D. and June B. Blackwood, have first rights to the "use of said water." It appears that the claimant described the flow rate on the original statement of claim filing as "50 plus" MI to reflect variable diversions of at least 50 MI based on variable flows in Foster Spring Creek. However, as described in the 1964 agreement, Blackwood Dry Creek LP has first rights to all water in Foster Spring Creek, and Foster Spring Creek typically flows at 100 MI. No additional irrigation water rights were claimed for irrigation from Foster Spring Creek on the Blackwood Dry Creek LP property.
- 26. Claim 41H 126858-00 is a fish and wildlife claim from an unnamed tributary of South Dry Creek. Blackwood requests the following changes to the point of diversion and reservoir record:
 - a. POD ID No. 1 should be removed from the claim.
 - b. The measurements of the Onstream Reservoir in POD ID No. 2 should be corrected as follows:
 - i. Dam Height: 9.00 feet
 - ii. Depth: 7.00 feet
 - iii. Surface Area: 0.66 Acres
 - iv. Capacity: 1.85 Acre-Feet
- 27. Blackwood requests modifications to resolve the issue remarks on this claim which state that there has been a post 1973 expansion of the water right.
- 28. Blackwood requests these changes based on information provided in the claim file. The second (northern) dam and reservoir on claim 41H 126858-00 was not constructed until sometime in 1976. Thus, the claimant should not have included the second, northern reservoir under the 41H 126858 00 statement of claim. The northern reservoir (Reservoir Record #1) and corresponding POD (POD ID #1) should be removed from 41H 126858 00 to accurately reflect the historic pre-1973 water use.
- 29. Blackwood further states DNRC appears to have misinterpreted the information on the 1986 reservoir questionnaire, and thus the reservoir record for the

southern, pre-1973 pond is inaccurate. Based on the 1986 reservoir questionnaire, GIS mapping of the pond based on historic aerials, and site visit, the southern, pre-1973 pond has a dam height of 9 feet, a maximum depth of approximately 7 feet, a surface area of 0.66 acres, and a capacity of 1.85 AF.

30. Any remaining issue remarks on these claims are for notice purposes only and can be removed.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The Montana Water Court has the authority to resolve issue remarks when the claim file and information available to the Court provide a sufficient basis to do so. Section 85-2-248(3), MCA.
- 2. A properly filed Statement of Claim for Existing Water Right is prima facie proof of its content. Section 85-2-227, MCA. This prima facie proof may be contradicted and overcome by other evidence that proves, by a preponderance of the evidence, that an element of the prima facie claim is incorrect. This is the burden of proof for every assertion that a claim is incorrect. Rule 19, W.R.Adj.R.
- 3. The degree or weight of evidence needed to contradict or overcome the prima facie proof statute is a preponderance of the evidence. *Burkhartsmeyer et al. v. Burkhartsmeyer et al.*, Case 40G-2, (MT Water Court Memorandum Opinion and Order Adopting Master's Report, Mar. 11, 1997). The Montana Supreme Court has defined preponderance as "a relatively modest standard that the statutory criteria are 'more probable than not' to have been met." *Hohenlohe v. State*, 2010 MT 203 ¶ 33, 357 Mont. 438, 240 P.3d 628.
- 4. The Montana Water Court is permitted to use information submitted by the Department of Natural Resources and Conservation, the statement of claim, information from approved compacts, and any other data obtained by the Court to evaluate water right claims. Section 85-2-231(2), MCA.
- 5. The Objection List issued in this basin gave all water users notice of the possible correction of the elements addressed in this Master's Report. This notice is reasonably calculated to inform parties of proceedings affecting their water rights.

6. For the above-mentioned reasons, the claims in this case should be modified as shown on the attached abstracts to accurately reflect historical use.

RECOMMENDATIONS

Based upon the above Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, this Master recommends that the Court make the changes specified above to correct the Preliminary Decree for this Basin. Post Decree Abstracts of Water Right Claims are served with this Report to confirm that the recommended changes have been made in the state's centralized record system.
