## NOTICE OF FILING OF MASTER'S REPORT

This Master's Report was filed with the Montana Water Court on the above stamped date. <u>Please review this report carefully.</u>

You may file a written objection to this Master's Report within **10 days** of the stamped date if you disagree or find errors with the Master's findings of fact, conclusions of law, or recommendations. Rule 23, W.R.Adj.R. If the Master's Report was mailed to you, the Montana Rules of Civil Procedure allow an additional 3 days be added to the 10-day objection period. Rule 6(d), M.R.Civ.P. If you file an objection, you must serve a copy of the objection to all parties on the service list found at the end of the Master's Report. The original objection and a certificate of mailing to all parties on the service list must be filed with the Water Court.

If you do not file a timely objection, the Water Court will conclude that you agree with the content of this Master's Report.

## **MASTER'S REPORT**

The above-captioned claims appeared in the Preliminary Decree for the Judith River (Basin 41S) and received objections from the United States of America (Bureau of Land Management) ("United States").

The claims were consolidated into Case 41S-0011-R-2024 on February 12, 2024, and a status conference was set. On June 10, 2024, claimants Doris Pallett, David Pallett, Leslie Pallett, Jr, Bruce Bennetts, Barbara Bennetts, Donald Pallett and Alta Mae Pallett filed letters stating that they would be willing to remove those portions of land descriptions claiming federal land (Doc. 15.00) and on June 20, 2024 this Court issued an Order requiring the United States to file documentation stating their position on the claimants proposed modifications to the claims.

On July 17, 2024, the United States filed a Response stating that adding clarifying remarks to the claims would resolve their objections. On July 19, 2024, an Order Setting Show Cause Filing Deadline was issued, requiring the claimants to file documentation stating their position on the modifications described in the US Response. The Order stated that "[i]f nothing is filed it will be viewed as agreement that claims should be modified pursuant to the proposed abstracts attached to the US July 17, 2024, filing". Nothing was filed in response to the Order.

## FINDINGS OF FACT

1. The following remark should be added to both claims:

Add land clarification remark: THE POINT OF DIVERSION AND PLACE OF USE DO NOT INCLUDE FEDERAL LAND LOCATED IN GOVERNMENT LOTS 1, 2, 4, IN THE E2NW, AND ALSO THE W2NW SECTION 21, TOWNSHIP 16N, RANGE 19E, FERGUS COUNTY.

2. The addition of the remarks would resolve the objections to the claims.

## PRINCIPLES OF LAW

1. The Montana Water Court has the authority to determine the extent of all water rights in the state as they existed prior to July 1, 1973. *Fellows v. Saylor*, 2016 MT 45, ¶ 25, 382 Mont. 298, 367 P.3d 732; §§ 85-2-233, -102(13), MCA.

- 2. A properly filed Statement of Claim for Existing Water Right is prima facie proof of its content. § 85-2-227, MCA. This prima facie proof may be contradicted and overcome by other evidence that proves, by a preponderance of the evidence, that the elements of the claim do not accurately reflect the beneficial use of the water right as it existed prior to July 1, 1973. This is the burden of proof for every assertion that a claim is incorrect. Rule 19, W.R.Adj.R.
- 3. The Water Court may use information submitted by the DNRC, the Statement of Claim, and any other data obtained by the Court to evaluate a water right. §§ 85-2-227, -231(2), MCA.

## **CONCLUSION OF LAW**

1. The remark described in Finding of Fact #1 should be placed on the claims. The placement of the remarks on the claims resolves the objections to the claims.

## RECOMMENDATION

1. Upon review the record in this case, the claims should be modified as described above. The objections to the claims should be resolved and should be dismissed.
