If you do not file a timely objection, the Water Court will conclude that you agree with the content of this Master's Report.

MASTER'S REPORT

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. The claim in this Case appeared in the Basin 40D Decree with an objection from United States of America (Bureau of Land Management) and was consolidated into case 40D-0022-R-2023.
- 2. Claimants Shelley Ryan and Thomas Ryan failed to respond to several Water Court deadlines. BLM reported attempts to contact Claimants but received no responses.
- 3. The Court set a deadline of April 29, 2024 for Claimants to state why they had not participated in this case. The Order stated if no response was filed, the Court would adopt the Objector's request to amend the place of use for this claim.
 - 4. Nothing was filed by Claimants.
- 5. Objector BLM stated that this claim includes lands belonging to the United States. BLM requests to remove those lands from the claim as follows:

6. No response was submitted by Claimants as of the date of this Report.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. Section 85-2-248(2), MCA requires the Water Court to resolve all issue remarks that are not resolved through the objection process. When resolving issue remarks, the Water Court must weigh the information resulting in the issue remark and the issue remark against the claimed water right. Section 85-2-247(2), MCA.
- 2. A properly filed Statement of Claim for Existing Water Right is prima facie proof of its content. Section 85-2-227, MCA. This prima facie proof may be contradicted and overcome by other evidence that proves, by a preponderance of the evidence, that an element of the prima facie claim is incorrect. This is the burden of proof for every assertion that a claim is incorrect. Rule 19, W.R.Adj.R.

- 3. If a claimant, objector, or intervenor fails to appear at a scheduled conference or hearing, or fails to comply with an order issued by the water court, the water court, upon motion, or its own initiative, may issue such orders of sanction with regard thereto as are just. Rule 22, W.R.Adj.R.
- 4. Pursuant to Section 85-2-248(9), MCA, and Rule 22, W.R.Adj.R., when a claimant fails to comply with an Order issued by the Water Court, including an Order issued by a Water Master appointed by the Court, the Court, upon motion, or its own initiative, can among other actions: 1) amend the elements of the claim to conform with the information in the claim file or information obtained by the Court, or 2) terminate the claim.
- 5. Claimants failed to provide any evidence to contradict Objector's assertion that the claim should not contain United States' property. The assertion combined with the lack of participation from Claimants are enough to justify the removal of the land from the claim.

RECOMMENDATIONS

The changes recommended above should be adopted. Post Decree Abstract of Water Right Claims is served with the Report to confirm that the above-changes have been adopted.
