NOTICE OF FILING OF MASTER'S REPORT

Rule 23, W.R.Adj.R. If the Master's Report was mailed to you, the Montana Rules of Civil Procedure allow an additional 3 days be added to the 10-day objection period. Rule 6(d), M.R.Civ.P. If you file an objection, you must serve a copy of the objection to all parties on the service list found at the end of the Master's Report. The original objection and a certificate of mailing to all parties on the service list must be filed with the Water Court.

If you do not file a timely objection, the Water Court will conclude that you agree with the content of this Master's Report.

MASTER'S REPORT

Claim 40G 44091-00 appeared in the Preliminary Decree for Sage Creek (Basin 40G) with issue remarks from the Montana Department of Natural Resources and Conservation's (DNRC).

Claim 41G 44091-00 was consolidated into Case 40G-0223-R-2024 to resolve the issue remarks.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Claim 40G 44091-00 received the following substantive issue remarks:

POINT OF DIVERSION NO. 4 AND NO. 5 APPEAR TO BE INCORRECT. POINT OF DIVERSION NO. 4 APPEARS TO BE THE NENWSW SEC 32 TWP 37N RGE 7 E LIBERTY COUNTY. POINT OF DIVERSION NO. 5 APPEARS TO BE THE NESWSE SEC 33 TWP 37N RGE 7 E LIBERTY COUNTY.

THIS CLAIM APPEARS TO BE CLAIMING TWO SEPARATE SOURCES OF WATER. MORE THAN ONE WATER RIGHT MAY BE INVOLVED.

- 2. On April 18, 2024, the Court consolidated the claim and ordered the Claimants to work with the DNRC to resolve the issue remarks.
- 3. On June 26, 2024, DNRC Water Resources Specialist Jamie Verploegen filed a *Memorandum* in this matter. The *Memo* states that the DNRC was contacted by claimant Bruce Duncan who met with the DNRC on June 19, 2024, to show on a map where the points of diversion are located for claim 40G 44091-00. According to the *Memo*, the points of diversion identified in the issue remark for Id Nos. 4 and 5 are correct based on the map provided by Mr. Duncan. Additionally, the *Memo* states that Mr. Duncan stated to the DNRC that the only source involved with claim 40G 44091-00 is Sage Creek. Therefore, the DNRC recommends the point of diversion be modified as described in the issue remark, the source remain as Sage Creek, and the issue remarks be removed.
- 4. Claim 40G 44091-00 also received a notice-type issue remark from the DNRC during its claims reexamination. No Objections were filed.

PRINCIPLES OF LAW

- 1. A properly filed Statement of Claim for an existing water right is prima facie proof of its content. Section 85-2-227, MCA; Rule 10, W.R.Adj.R.
- 2. Prima facie proof may be contradicted and overcome by a preponderance of the evidence. Rule 19, W.R.Adj.R.
- 3. A preponderance of the evidence is evidence that shows a fact is "more probable than not." *Hohenlohe v. State*, 2010 MT 203, ¶ 33, 357 Mont. 438, 240 P.3d 628.

- 4. If prima facie status is overcome, the burden shifts back to the claimant to demonstrate historical use. *79 Ranch v. Pitsch*, 204 Mont. 426, 432-33, 666 P.2d 215, 218 (1983).
- 5. Section 85-2-248(2), MCA, requires that the Water Court resolve all issue remarks that are not resolved through the objection process. *See also* Rule 7, W.R.Adj.R.
- 6. The Water Court may use information submitted by the DNRC, the Statement of Claim, and any other data obtained by the Court to evaluate a water right. Sections 85-2-227, -231(2), MCA.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The information in the record is sufficient to resolve the above-listed issue remarks appearing on the claim. Based on the information contained in DNRC Water Resources Specialist Jamie Verploegen's *Memo*, point of diversion Id Nos. 4 and 5 of claim 40G 44091-00 should be modified as described in Finding of Fact No. 1, the source should remain listed as Sage Creek, and the issue remarks should be removed from the claim.
- 2. The notice-type issue remark appearing on claim 40G 44091-00 served its notice purpose and should be removed from the claim.

RECOMMENDATIONS

Based on the foregoing Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, this Master recommends that the Court adopt the changes as outlined above.

A post decree abstract of the water right claim reflecting the recommended changes is attached to this Report.
