If you do not file a timely objection, the Water Court will conclude that you agree with the content of this Master's Report.

MASTER'S REPORT

Claim 41E 44363-00 appeared in the Preliminary Decree with the following issue remarks:

THE CLAIMED FLOW RATE APPEARS TO BE HIGH FOR THIS PURPOSE AND CANNOT BE CONFIRMED DUE TO LACK OF DATA.

IT APPEARS THE VOLUME FOR THIS DOMESTIC CLAIM MAY NOT BE CORRECTLY DESCRIBED BY THE VOLUME REMARK

The issue remarks were not addressed through the objection process. The Water Court is required to resolve the issues raised by each issue remark. Section 85-2-248, MCA. Under Section 85-2-248(3), MCA, information in the claim file or other information obtained by the Court can be reviewed to determine if it provides a sufficient basis to resolve the issue raised by a remark and the Court can provide the claimants an opportunity to file additional information or evidence.

On April 19, 2024 Jonathan C. Oatman filed a response providing information which addresses and resolves the issue remarks. Nothing was filed by the other claimants. The June 6, 2024 Order Updating Caption And Service List and Reissued Order Distributing Copy Of Filing and Order Setting Filing Deadline states:

> Mr. Oatman's Response is supported by the attachments to his Response: the flow rate and volume were already determined in the 1990 proceedings for this claim and the issue remarks should be removed. The Court needs to be sure all of the co-claimants agree with Mr. Oatman's Response. If any co-claimant does <u>not</u> agree with Mr. Oatman's Response, a written statement explaining that disagreement must be filed by the deadline stated below. If any co-claimant <u>agrees</u> with Mr. Oatman's Response, nothing needs to be filed. Therefore, it is ORDERED that the deadline is **June 28, 2024** for any co-claimant to file a written statement explaining their disagreement with the Response. If nothing is filed by a co-claimant, the Court will conclude that co-claimant agrees with Mr. Oatman's Response.

Nothing was filed. These documents are viewable in the Court's FullCourt Enterprise case management system.

APPLICABLE LAW

"All issue remarks to claims that are not resolved through the filing of an objection as provided in 85-2-233 must be resolved as provided in this section." Section 85-2-248(2), MCA.

Judicial notice is taken of the Temporary Preliminary Decree proceedings for this claim in Case 41E-12. Rule 202, M.R.Evid.

A properly filed Statement of Claim for Existing Water Right is prima facie proof of its content pursuant to section 85-2-227, MCA. This prima facie proof may be contradicted and overcome by other evidence that proves, by a preponderance of the evidence, that the elements of the claim do not accurately reflect the beneficial use of the water right as it existed prior to July 1, 1973. This is the burden of proof for every assertion that a claim is incorrect including for claimants objecting to their own claims. Rule 19, W.R.Adj.R.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. The flow rate and volume of this domestic claim were litigated and determined during the Temporary Preliminary Decree proceedings in Case 41E-12. The claim appeared in the Temporary Preliminary Decree as a mining claim, flow rate 6.25 CFS, and volume 20.00 AC-FT. The Montana Department of Fish, Wildlife and Parks objected to the claim. The parties' Stipulation states that the purpose should be changed to domestic, the flow rate reduced to 100.00 GPM and the volume should be limited to the amount historically used for mining purposes. Instead of a quantification, they agreed to removing the 20.00 AC-FT and adding the following remark: THIS RIGHT IS LIMITED TO THE VOLUME OF WATER HISTORICALLY USED FOR MINING PURPOSES.

2. The Preliminary Decree states the flow rate is 100.00 GPM as adjudicated during the Temporary Preliminary Decree proceedings. The flow rate issue remark should be removed as moot.

3. The Preliminary Decree states for the volume: THIS RIGHT IS LIMITED TO THE VOLUME OF WATER HISTORICALLY USED FOR MINING PURPOSES. The volume issue remark should be removed as moot.

CONCLUSION OF LAW

The information already in the claim file contradicts the issue remarks. The issue remarks should be removed without evidentiary hearing. Sections 85-2-248(3) and (11), MCA.

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RECOMMENDATIONS

Based upon the above Findings of Fact and Conclusion of Law, this Master recommends that the Court make the changes specified in the Findings of Fact to correct the Preliminary Decree for this Basin. A Post Decree Abstract of Water Right Claim is served with this Report to confirm the recommended changes have been made in the state's centralized record system.
