MASTER'S REPORT

The above-captioned claims appeared in the Preliminary Decree for the Judith River (Basin 41S) with issue remarks.

The claims were consolidated into Case 41S-0238-R-2023 on February 8, 2024, and the claimants were ordered to work with the Department of Natural Resources and Conservation to resolve the issue remarks on the claims. On May 30, 2024, a Memorandum ("Memo") was filed (Doc. 1 3.00).

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Claim 41S 10439-00 was decreed with the following issue remarks: FLOW RATE MAY REQUIRE MODIFICATION BASED ON RESOLUTION OF MAXIMUM ACRES ISSUE.

THE TYPE OF HISTORICAL RIGHT, PRIORITY DATE, AND FLOW RATE MAY BE QUESTIONABLE. THE CLAIMS FOLLOWING THIS STATEMENT USE THE SAME FILED APPROPRIATION TO DOCUMENT THE RIGHT. THE COMBINED FLOW RATE FOR THIS GROUP OF CLAIMS EXCEEDS THE TOTAL OF THE ORIGINAL APPROPRIATION. 41S 10439-00, 41S 139297-00, 41S 210793-00.

THE FERGUS COUNTY WATER RESOURCES SURVEY (1970) APPEARS TO INDICATE 0.00 ACRES IRRIGATED.

- 2. The Memo recommends reducing the maximum acres to 47.75 acres which would resolve the place of use issue remarks. The Memo additionally recommended reducing the flow rate of claim 41S 139297-00 which would resolve the over filed Notice of Appropriation.
 - 3. Claim 41S 10442-00 was decreed with the following issue remarks:

FLOW RATE MAY REQUIRE MODIFICATION BASED ON RESOLUTION OF MAXIMUM ACRES ISSUE.

THE CLAIMANT DID NOT IDENTIFY THE PERIOD OF DIVERSION FOR THIS RIGHT. A PERIOD OF DIVERSION HAS BEEN ADDED TO MATCH THE PERIOD OF USE. IF NO OBJECTIONS ARE RECEIVED TO THE PERIOD OF DIVERSION OR PERIOD OF USE, THOSE ELEMENTS WILL BE DECREED AS SHOWN ON THIS ABSTRACT AND THIS ISSUE REMARK WILL BE REMOVED FROM THIS CLAIM.

THE MAXIMUM COMBINED ACRES FOR THIS GROUP OF SUPPLEMENTAL CLAIMS MAY REQUIRE MODIFICATION PENDING RESOLUTION OF MAXIMUM IRRIGATED ACRES ISSUE.

THE CLAIMED VOLUME APPEARS TO BE EXCESSIVE FOR THE CLAIMED PURPOSE. THE CLAIMED VOLUME EQUALS 34.5 TIMES THE CAPACITY OF THE RESERVOIR.

- 4. The Memo recommends the acreage be reduced to 40 acres in the W2SW S29, T15N, R16E. A map of the place of use is attached to the Memo. The Memo states that adoption of the recommendation would resolve the place of use issue remarks. The Memo further recommends reducing the volume to 17.27 acre-feet, adoption of which would resolve the volume issue remark. Finally, the Memo recommends removing the flow rate issue remark.
 - 5. Claim 41S 10443-00 was decreed with the following issue remarks:

THE CLAIMANT DID NOT IDENTIFY THE PERIOD OF DIVERSION FOR THIS RIGHT. A PERIOD OF DIVERSION HAS BEEN ADDED TO MATCH THE PERIOD OF USE. IF NO OBJECTIONS ARE RECEIVED TO THE PERIOD OF DIVERSION OR PERIOD OF USE, THOSE ELEMENTS WILL BE DECREED AS SHOWN ON THIS ABSTRACT AND THIS ISSUE REMARK WILL BE REMOVED FROM THIS CLAIM.

RESERVOIR RECORD WAS MODIFIED AS A RESULT OF DNRC REVIEW UNDER MONTANA WATER COURT REEXAMINATION ORDERS. IF NO OBJECTIONS ARE FILED TO THIS CLAIM, THESE ELEMENTS WILL REMAIN AS THEY APPEAR ON THIS ABSTRACT AND THE REMARK WILL BE REMOVED FROM THE CLAIM.

THE PRIORITY DATE MAY BE QUESTIONABLE. THIS CLAIM IS FOR A FILED APPROPRIATION ON UNNAMED TRIBUTARY OF ROSS' FORK CREEK WITH A PRIORITY DATE PREDATING CASE NO 756, FERGUS COUNTY. IF NO OBJECTIONS ARE FILED TO PRIORITY DATE OR TYPE OF HISTORICAL RIGHT, THESE ELEMENTS WILL BE DECREED AS SHOWN ON THIS ABSTRACT AND THIS REMARK WILL BE REMOVED.

CLAIMED VOLUME EXCEEDS CAPACITY OF RESERVOIR PLUS EVAPORATIVE LOSSES. THE CLAIMED VOLUME CAN BE CONTESTED BY PROPER OBJECTION. IF NO OBJECTIONS ARE FILED TO THIS CLAIM THE VOLUME WILL BE DECREED AS CLAIMED, AND THIS REMARK WILL BE REMOVED FROM THE CLAIM.

THE CLAIMED VOLUME APPEARS TO BE EXCESSIVE FOR THE CLAIMED PURPOSE. THE CLAIMED VOLUME EQUALS 37 TIMES THE CAPACITY OF THE RESERVOIR.

- 6. The Memo recommends reducing the volume to 19.75 acre-feet. The memo states that adoption of the recommendation would resolve the volume issue remark.
- 7. The memo states that claims 41S 10442-00 and 41S 10443-00 utilize the same reservoir. The memo states that "adjusting the reservoir record of either claim would be outside the scope of the DNRCs work". It appears appropriate to harmonize the reservoir records. As the volume recommendation for claim 41S 10442-00 was calculated based on the size of the reservoir, it appears appropriate to decree the claim with the 19.75 acrefeet volume as well.
 - 8. Claim 41S 139297-00 was decreed with the following issue remarks:

THE CLAIMED MEANS OF DIVERSION CANNOT BE IDENTIFIED FROM AVAILABLE DATA.

FLOW RATE MAY REQUIRE MODIFICATION BASED ON RESOLUTION OF MAXIMUM ACRES ISSUE.

THE TYPE OF HISTORICAL RIGHT, PRIORITY DATE, AND FLOW RATE MAY BE QUESTIONABLE. THE CLAIMS FOLLOWING THIS STATEMENT USE THE SAME FILED APPROPRIATION TO DOCUMENT THE RIGHT. THE COMBINED FLOW RATE FOR THIS GROUP OF CLAIMS EXCEEDS THE TOTAL OF THE ORIGINAL APPROPRIATION. 41S 10439-00, 41S 139297-00, 41S 210793-00.

THE POINTS OF DIVERSION MAY BE INCORRECT. THE LOCATIONS OF THE DIVERSIONS CANNOT BE IDENTIFIED FROM AVAILABLE DATA.

- 9. The Memo recommends reducing the maximum acres to 95 acres, flow rate to 8.63 CFS and that POD ID#3 be removed from the claim. Reducing the flow rate to 8.63 CFS brings the total flow rate for claims 41S 10439-00, 41S 139297-00 and 41S 210793-00 to the 12.5 CFS claimed by the Notice of Appropriation that is the historical basis for the claims. If the reductions are adopted, the Memo recommends that the acreage, overfiled Notice of Appropriation, point of diversion and means of diversion issue remarks be removed.
 - 10. Claim 41S 210792-00 was decreed with the following issue remarks:

FLOW RATE MAY REQUIRE MODIFICATION BASED ON RESOLUTION OF MAXIMUM ACRES ISSUE.

CLAIM FILED LATE 04/27/1984. IN ADDITION TO BEING SUBORDINATE TO ALL INDIAN AND FEDERAL RESERVED WATER RIGHTS AND ALL VALID TIMELY FILED CLAIMS BASED ON STATE LAW, THIS RIGHT MAY ALSO BE SUBORDINATE TO CERTAIN PERMITS AND RESERVATIONS OF WATER. SEE SECTION 85-2-221 MCA.

 - 12. Claim 41S 210793-00 was decreed with the following issue remarks:

FLOW RATE MAY REQUIRE MODIFICATION BASED ON RESOLUTION OF MAXIMUM ACRES ISSUE.

CLAIM FILED LATE 04/27/1984. IN ADDITION TO BEING SUBORDINATE TO ALL INDIAN AND FEDERAL RESERVED WATER RIGHTS AND ALL VALID TIMELY FILED CLAIMS BASED ON STATE LAW, THIS RIGHT MAY ALSO BE SUBORDINATE TO CERTAIN PERMITS AND RESERVATIONS OF WATER. SEE SECTION 85-2-221 MCA.

THE FERGUS COUNTY WATER RESOURCES SURVEY (1970) APPEARS TO INDICATE 2.00 ACRES IRRIGATED. A DESCRIPTION OF THESE ACRES IS IN THE CLAIM FILE.

THE MAXIMUM COMBINED ACRES FOR THIS GROUP OF SUPPLEMENTAL CLAIMS MAY REQUIRE MODIFICATION PENDING RESOLUTION OF MAXIMUM IRRIGATED ACRES ISSUE.

13. The Memo recommends reducing the acreage to 40 acres in the W2SW of S29, T15N, R16E. The Memo states that if the recommendation is accepted the DNRC recommends the issue remarks be removed.

14. The Memo states that the claimant requested that acreage for claims 41S 10443-00, 41S 139297-00, 41S 210792-00 and 41S 210793-00 "be reassigned" to different places of use. It is unclear whether this 'reassignment' would be reflective of historical use or a post July 1, 1973, change. If claimant believes it appropriate, claimant may file a Motion to Amend with this Court.

15. Claim 41S 30131145 was decreed with the following issue remarks:

THIS CLAIM NUMBER WAS NOT INCLUDED IN THE BASIN 41S DECREE ISSUED 05/17/1984.

THE CLAIMED FLOW RATE EXCEEDS THE 35 GPM GUIDELINE FOR THIS PURPOSE AND CANNOT BE CONFIRMED DUE TO LACK OF DATA.

ACCORDING TO CADASTRAL PROPERTY OWNERSHIP RECORDS, AS OF 05/08/2021, THE PROPERTY ON WHICH THIS WATER RIGHT IS USED APPEARS TO BE OWNED BY HARDWIG LARRY & DENICE.

ACCORDING TO CADASTRAL PROPERTY OWNERSHIP RECORDS, AS OF 05/08/2021, THE PROPERTY ON WHICH THIS WATER RIGHT IS USED APPEARS TO BE OWNED BY VIERTEL SAMUEL RANCH LLC.

THE CLAIMED PLACE OF USE COULD NOT BE IDENTIFIED FROM DATA SUBMITTED WITH THE CLAIM.

THE POINT OF DIVERSION LEGAL LAND DESCRIPTION COULD NOT BE REFINED FROM INFORMATION IN THE CLAIM FILE.

THIS CLAIM APPEARS TO BE CLAIMING SEVERAL SEPARATE SOURCES OF WATER. MORE THAN ONE WATER RIGHT MAY BE INVOLVED.

16. The Memo recommends reducing the flow rate to 180 GPM, removing one point of diversion and modifying the remaining point of diversion to the SESENW S31 T15N R16E and modifying the place of use as follows:

The Memo states that adoption of the recommendations would resolve the applicable issue remarks.

17. Claim 41S 30131147 was decreed with the following issue remarks:

THIS CLAIM NUMBER WAS NOT INCLUDED IN THE BASIN 41S DECREE ISSUED 05/17/1984.

THE CLAIMED FLOW RATE EXCEEDS THE 35 GPM GUIDELINE FOR THIS PURPOSE AND CANNOT BE CONFIRMED DUE TO LACK OF DATA.

THE PLACE OF USE LEGAL LAND DESCRIPTION COULD NOT BE REFINED FROM INFORMATION IN THE CLAIM FILE.

THE POINT OF DIVERSION LEGAL LAND DESCRIPTION COULD NOT BE REFINED FROM INFORMATION IN THE CLAIM FILE.

- 18. The Memo recommends reducing the flow rate to 180 GPM, modifying the point of diversion to the SESWNE S31 T15N R16E and modifying the place of use to the NE S31 T15N R16E. Adoption of the recommendations would resolve the remarks implicating flow rate, point of diversion and place of use.
- 19. The remaining issue remarks not resolved by adopting the Memo recommendations are notice-type remark No objections were filed, the remarks should be removed as they have served their purpose and require no additional proceedings to resolve.

PRINCIPLES OF LAW

- 1. The Montana Water Court has the authority to determine the extent of all water rights in the state as they existed prior to July 1, 1973. *Fellows v. Saylor*, 2016 MT 45, ¶ 25, 382 Mont. 298, 367 P.3d 732; §§ 85-2-233, -102(13), MCA.
- 2. A properly filed Statement of Claim for Existing Water Right is prima facie proof of its content. § 85-2-227, MCA. This prima facie proof may be contradicted and overcome by other evidence that proves, by a preponderance of the evidence, that the elements of the claim do not accurately reflect the beneficial use of the water right as it existed prior to July 1, 1973. This is the burden of proof for every assertion that a claim is incorrect. Rule 19, W.R.Adj.R.

CONCLUSION OF LAW

1. The claims should be modified as discussed above.

RECOMMENDATION

1. Upon review the record in this case, the above-captioned claims should be modified as discussed above. The issue remarks should be removed from the claims.
