MASTER'S REPORT

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. 69 Ranch, LLC (69 Ranch) is the record owner of claims 41S 119061-00 and 41S 211129-00.
- 2. Claims 41S 119061-00 and 41S 211129-00 were decreed with DNRC issue remarks:

Claim 41S 119061-00:

- THE JUDITH BASIN COUNTY WATER RESOURCES SURVEY (1963) APPEARS TO INDICATE 0.00 ACRES IRRIGATED.
- THE CLAIMED VOLUME APPEARS TO BE EXCESSIVE FOR THE CLAIMED PURPOSE. THE CLAIMED VOLUME EQUALS 25.57 TIMES THE CAPACITY OF THE RESERVOIR.
- FLOW RATE MAY REQUIRE MODIFICATION BASED ON RESOLUTION OF MAXIMUM ACRES ISSUE.

Claim 41S 211129-00:

- THE CLAIMED MEANS OF DIVERSION DOES NOT APPEAR STANDARDIZED AND CANNOT BE CLARIFIED FROM AVAILABLE DATA.
- THE JUDITH BASIN COUNTY WATER RESOURCES SURVEY (1963) APPEARS TO INDICATE 0.00 ACRES IRRIGATED.
- FLOW RATE MAY REQUIRE MODIFICATION BASED ON RESOLUTION OF MAXIMUM ACRES ISSUE.


Additional remarks were decreed on the claims, but they are either notice-type remarks or do not require further attention.

- 3. 69 Ranch was ordered to meet with a DNRC employee to address the unresolved DNRC issue remarks.
- 4. DNRC Water Resource Specialist Carli Bluhm filed Memorandums stating the Claimant did not contact the DNRC. (Doc.* 2.00). Ms. Bluhm indicated she reviewed scanned claim files, topographic maps, the Judith County Water Resource Survey, and aerial photos to prepare the Memorandum; maps and proposed abstracts were attached to the Memorandum. Ms. Bluhm indicated that nobody contacted her on behalf of 69 Ranch.

Ms. Bluhm recommended the following modifications be made to claims 41S 119061-00 and 41S 211129-00 to represent the historical use of the claims and address the issue remarks:



- 5. Ms. Bluhm also recommended the means of diversion for claim 41S 211129-00 be modified to "ditch." Additionally, Ms. Bluhm noted a "potential point of diversion" for claim 41S 211129-00 but did not recommend the point of diversion be modified. Without additional information from the Claimant regarding the point of diversion and means of diversion, there is not enough information regarding the conveyance system to change what was claimed.
- 6. An Order was issued setting a deadline for Claimant 69 Ranch file a statement agreeing or disagreeing with the modifications recommended by Ms. Bluhm. The Order indicated that if nothing were filed by the deadline, this Water Master would conclude Claimant 69 Ranch Inc. agrees with the recommended modifications. The Order included the following language:

Failure to comply with the terms of this Order may result in sanctions, <u>up to and including entry of default and termination of a water right claim or dismissal of objections</u>. Rule 22, W.R.Adj.R.

Nothing was filed by the deadline.

PRINCIPLES AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The issue remarks were not addressed through the objection process. The Water Court is required to resolve the issues raised by each issue remark. Section 85-2-248, MCA.
- 2. A properly filed Statement of Claim for an existing water right is prima facie proof of its content. Section 85-2-227, MCA. This prima facie validity may be overcome by evidence showing that one or more elements of the claim are incorrect. This standard of proof applies to objectors or claimants objecting to their own water right claims. Rule 19, W.R.Adj.R., *Nelson v. Brooks*, 2014 MT 120; 375 Mont.86, 95; 329 P.3d 558, 564.
- 3. According to Rule 22, W.R.Adj.R., if a claimant, objector, or intervenor fails to appear at a scheduled conference or hearing or fails to comply with an order issued by the Water Court, the Water Court may issue such orders of sanction with regard thereto as are just.
- 4. The issue remarks decreed on claims 41S 199061-00 and 41S 211129-00 referencing modifying or adding supplemental rights remarks are not relevant. Supplemental rights remarks decreed on claims no longer include a quantified acreage figure, and ultimately supplemental rights remarks will be removed at final decree.
- 5. Claim 41S 211129-00 is a late claim. The late claim issue remark decreed on the claim gave notice that the claim could be subordinate, and therefore junior to certain permits and reservations of water. Any party asserting a superior claim to water based on a permit or reservation was required to file an objection to that late claim during the Basin 41S objection period. Because no such objections were filed, this remark can now be removed from the claim.
- 6. The notice-type issue remarks decreed on claims 41S 119061-00 and 41S 211129-00 have served their purpose. As no objections were filed, no further proceedings are required.

RECOMMENDATIONS

- 1. Claims 41S 119061-00 and 41S 211129-00 should be modified as shown in Finding of Fact No. 4.
- 2. The issue remarks should be removed from claims 41S 119061-00 and 41S 211129-00.

Post Decree Abstracts of Water Right Claims are served with the Report for review.
