If you file an objection, you must serve a copy of the objection to all parties on the service list found at the end of the Master's Report. The original objection and a certificate of mailing to all parties on the service list must be filed with the Water Court.

If you do not file a timely objection, the Water Court will conclude that you agree with the content of this Master's Report.

### **MASTER'S REPORT**

### FINDINGS OF FACT

1. The record co-owners of domestic claims 41S 100192-00 and 41S 100193-

00 are Carrie Mantooth and Kelly Mantooth. The record co-owners of stock claim 41S

100194-00 are Robert N. Boie, Carrie Mantooth, and Kelly Mantooth. And the record

co-owners of stock claim 41S 100195-00 are Robert N. Boie, Carrie Mantooth, Kelly

Mantooth, Laura S. Melton, and Ross W. Melton.

2. Claims 41S 100192-00 and 41S 100194-00 are multiple uses of the same

historical right. Both claims were decreed with the following DNRC issue remark:

THE TYPE OF HISTORICAL RIGHT, PRIORITY DATE, AND FLOW RATE MAY BE QUESTIONABLE. THE CLAIMS FOLLOWING THIS STATEMENT USE THE SAME FILED APPROPRIATION TO DOCUMENT THE RIGHT. THE COMBINED FLOW RATE FOR THIS GROUP OF CLAIMS EXCEEDS THE TOTAL OF THE ORIGINAL APPROPRIATION. 41S 100192-00, 41S 100194-00.

Similarly, claims 41S 100193-00 and 41S 100195-00 are multiple uses of the same historical right. Claims 41S 100193-00 and 41S 100195-00 were decreed with the following DNRC issue remark:

THE TYPE OF HISTORICAL RIGHT, PRIORITY DATE, AND FLOW RATE MAY BE QUESTIONABLE. THE CLAIMS FOLLOWING THIS STATEMENT USE THE SAME FILED APPROPRIATION TO DOCUMENT THE RIGHT. THE COMBINED FLOW RATE FOR THIS GROUP OF CLAIMS EXCEEDS THE TOTAL OF THE ORIGINAL APPROPRIATION. 41S 100193-00, 41S 100195-00.

All issue remarks must be addressed.

3. The documentation supporting both sets of claims is a GW4, Declaration of

Vested Groundwater Rights, which was attached to the Statements of Claims. The GW4 states the maximum amount of water claimed is "400 gal/hr":

Conflicting information was provided on the individual Statements of Claims. The claimed flow rate for claims 41S 100192-00 and 41S 100194-00 was 10.00 gallons per minute (600.00 gallons per hour). The claimed flow rate for claims 41S 100193-00 and 41S 100195-00 was 40.00 gallons per minute (2,400 gallons per hour).

During examination of the claims, the DNRC examiner added the over-filed notice of appropriation issue remarks to the claims because they overclaimed the 400.00 gallons per hour (6.70 gallons per minute) indicated on the GW4 form. Based on the information available, it appears the flow rate for all claims should be reduced to 6.70 gallons per minute (gpm), which is approximately the equivalent of 400.00 gallons per hour.

4. An Order was issued to determine if Claimants Robert N. Boie, Carrie Mantooth, Kelly Mantooth, Laura S. Melton, and Ross W. Melton agreed or disagreed that the flow rates for claims 41S 100192-00, 41S 100193-00, 41S 100194-00, and 41S 100195-00 should be reduced to 6.70 gpm. The Order indicated that if nothing were filed by the deadline, this Water Master would conclude the Claimants agree the flow rates should be reduced to 6.70 gpm. The Order included the following language:

Failure to comply with the terms of this Order may result in sanctions, <u>up to and</u> including entry of default and termination of a water right claim or dismissal of <u>objections</u>. Rule 22, W.R.Adj.R.

Nothing was filed by the deadline.

#### PRINCIPLES AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The issue remarks were not addressed through the objection process. The Water Court is required to resolve the issues raised by each issue remark. Section 85-2-248, MCA. Under Section 85-2-248(3), MCA, information in the claim file or other information obtained by the Court can be reviewed to determine if it provides a sufficient basis to resolve the issue raised by a remark and the Court can provide the claimant an opportunity to file additional information or evidence.

2. A properly filed Statement of Claim for an existing water right is prima facie proof of its content. Section 85-2-227, MCA. This prima facie validity may be overcome by evidence showing that one or more elements of the claim are incorrect. This standard of proof applies to objectors or claimants objecting to their own water right claims. Rule 19, W.R.Adj.R., *Nelson v. Brooks*, 2014 MT 120; 375 Mont.86, 95; 329 P.3d 558, 564.

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3. Pursuant to Rule 22, W.R.Adj.R., if a claimant, objector, or intervenor fails to appear at a scheduled conference or hearing or fails to comply with an order issued by the Water Court, the Water Court may issue such orders of sanction with regard thereto as are just.

#### **RECOMMENDATIONS**

1. The flow rate for claims 41S 100192-00, 41S 100193-00, 41S 100194-00, and 41S 100195-00 should be reduced to 6.70 gpm.

2. The issue remarks should be removed from claims 41S 100192-00, 41S 100193-00, 41S 100194-00, and 41S 100195-00.
