# **MASTER'S REPORT**

Water right claim 41I 89894-00 appeared in the Preliminary Decree for the Missouri River above Holter Dam (Basin 41I) issued June 24, 2022. The claim received issue remarks from the Department of Natural Resources and Conservation (DNRC)

raising potential legal or factual issues with the claim. Staubach Creek Ranch LLC filed a Notice of Intent to Appear in proceedings pertaining to this claim. The Water Court consolidated the claims into case 41I-2020-R-2024 to address the remarks.

On March 7, 2024, Staubach Creek Ranch withdrew its Notice of Intent to Appear. On March 14, 2024, the Claimant filed a Concurrence with Proposed Resolution of Issue Remarks, which states that the Claimant agrees with the resolution of issue remarks described below.

# FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Claim 41I 89894-00 appeared in the Preliminary Decree as a claim to water from Beaver Creek for irrigating 69 acres. It received the following substantive issue remarks:

THE BROADWATER COUNTY WATER RESOURCES SURVEY (1956) APPEARS TO INDICATE 25.00 ACRES IRRIGATED. A DESCRIPTION OF THESE ACRES IS IN THE CLAIM FILE.

THE MAXIMUM COMBINED ACRES FOR THIS GROUP OF SUPPLEMENTAL CLAIMS MAY REQUIRE MODIFICATION PENDING RESOLUTION OF MAXIMUM IRRIGATED ACRES ISSUE.

FLOW RATE MAY REQUIRE MODIFICATION BASED ON RESOLUTION OF MAXIMUM ACRES ISSUE.

The Water Court previously determined the maximum acres of this claim in a December 8, 1997 Master's Report in Case 41I-113 (adopted January 27, 1998). The Water Master made the following factual finding:

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The Water Court has already addressed the irrigated acres and the issues raised by the substantive remarks are resolved. 2. The claim also received the following remark that served only to provide notice to the claimant and other water users in the Preliminary Decree (Notice Only Remark):

THE TIMELY FILED OBJECTION OF CHARLES REYNOLDS WAS AMENDED BY AGREEMENT OF THE PARTIES TO INCLUDE POINT OF DIVERSION BECAUSE THESE ELEMENTS WERE NOT INCLUDED ON THE OBJECTION LIST, ANY WATER USER WHOSE RIGHTS MAY BE ADVERSELY AFFECTED BY ENFORCEMENT OF THESE CHANGES MAY PETITION THE APPROPRIATE COURT FOR RELIEF OR MAY FILE AN OBJECTION AT THE PRELIMINARY DECREE.

# PRINCIPLES OF LAW

1. Section 85-2-248(2), MCA requires the Water Court to resolve all issue remarks that are not resolved through the objection process. The Montana Water Court has the authority to resolve issue remarks when the claim file and information available to the Court provide a sufficient basis to do so. § 85-2-248(3), MCA.

## CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Findings of Fact above are supported by a preponderance of the evidence. The issues raised by the substantive issue remarks are resolved and the Notice Only Remark has served its notice purpose. The issue remarks should be removed from the claim.

# **RECOMMENDATIONS**

Based on the foregoing Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, this Master recommends that the Court remove the issue remarks from the claim.

A Post Decree Abstract of Water Right Claim reflecting the recommended changes is attached to this Report for review.
