MASTER'S REPORT

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Claimants Torger S. Oaas, Coyote Creek, and Fergus County School District #1 are the record co-owners of claim 41S 28848-00. Claimant Fergus County School District #84 is the record owner of claim 41S 139599-00. Claimant Fergus County School District #1 is the record owner of claim 41S 140042-00.
- 2. The Claimants were ordered to meet with a DNRC employee to address the following unresolved issue remarks decreed on claims in this Case:

Claim 41S 28848-00:

THE MAXIMUM NUMBER OF ACRES CLAIMED ON THE ORIGINAL STATEMENT OF CLAIM IS 33.00 ACRES. THE DNRC'S RE-EXAMINATION WAS OF THESE ORIGINAL CLAIMED ACRES.

THE CLAIMED MEANS OF DIVERSION CANNOT BE IDENTIFIED FROM AVAILABLE DATA.

THE FERGUS COUNTY WATER RESOURCES SURVEY (1970) APPEARS TO INDICATE 0.00 ACRES IRRIGATED.

USDA AERIAL PHOTOGRAPH NO(S). 30027-278-194, DATED 09/25/1979, APPEARS TO INDICATE 20.60 ACRES IRRIGATED. A DESCRIPTION OF THESE ACRES IS IN THE CLAIM FILE.

FLOW RATE MAY REQUIRE MODIFICATION BASED ON RESOLUTION OF MAXIMUM ACRES ISSUE

Claims 41S 139599-00:

THIS CLAIM AND WATER RIGHT NO. 41S 44519-00 APPEAR TO BE REDUNDANT FILINGS. IT APPEARS ONLY ONE WATER RIGHT IS INVOLVED.

THE PRIORITY DATE MAY BE QUESTIONABLE. NO DOCUMENTATION AS REQUIRED BY THE 1961 GROUNDWATER CODE WAS SUBMITTED TO SUPPORT THIS CLAIM.

Claim 41S 140042-00:

THE FERGUS COUNTY WATER RESOURCES SURVEY (1970) APPEARS TO INDICATE 0.00 ACRES IRRIGATED.

USDA AERIAL PHOTOGRAPH NO(S). 30027-278-194, DATED 09/25/1979, APPEARS TO INDICATE 2.50 ACRES IRRIGATED. A DESCRIPTION OF THESE ACRES IS IN THE CLAIM FILE.

THE POINT OF DIVERSION MAY BE INCORRECT. THE LOCATION OF THE PUMP CANNOT BE IDENTIFIED FROM AVAILABLE DATA.

FLOW RATE MAY REQUIRE MODIFICATION BASED ON RESOLUTION OF MAXIMUM ACRES ISSUE.

3. On May 2, 2024, DNRC Water Resource Specialist Brandon Ahlgren filed a Memorandum stating he was contacted by representatives of Coyote Creek and Fergus County School District #84. (Doc1. 2.00). Mr. Ahlgren attached maps to the

Memorandum. Mr. Ahlgren stated he was not contacted by Torger S. Oaas or a representative of Fergus County School District #1.

4. **Claim 41S 28848-00** (Coyote Creek, Torger S. Oaas, Fergus County School District #1): Based on the available information, Mr. Ahlgren recommended reducing claim 41S 28848-00 as follows, addressing the issue remarks:

5. Claim 41S 139599-00 (Fergus County School District #84): Claim 41S 139599-00 was previously the subject of a Closing Order in which issue remarks were added to the claim to be addressed during the Preliminary Decree. Unfortunately, the issue remark implicating groundwater certificate 41S 44519-00 was not properly updated during reexamination of the claim. The issue remark *should* have indicated that groundwater certificate 41S 44519-00 and claim 41S 139599-00 are associated rights, instead the issue remark presently on the claim was added to the claim (indicating they are duplicate filings). Mr. Ahlgren recommended the issue remark be removed and an information remark be added to claim 41S 139599-00; an associated rights remark is already present.

According to Mr. Ahlgren, the representative of Fergus County School District #84 was unable to provide a GW filing to support the claimed July 4, 1963 priority date. Mr. Ahlgren recommended the priority date for claim 41S 139599-00 be adjusted to the date of filing of the Statement of Claim. The priority date was already decreed as April 30, 1982; as such, no priority date modifications are required.

6. **Claim 41S 140042-00** (Fergus County School District #1): Based on the available information, Mr. Ahlgren recommends reducing claim 41S 140042-00 as follows, addressing the issue remarks:

The Order also set a deadline for Claimant Fergus County School District #1 to file a statement agreeing or disagreeing with the following modifications to claim 41S 140042-00:



The Order indicated that if nothing were filed by the deadline, this Water Master would conclude the Claimant agrees with the proposed modifications.

The following language was included in the Order:

Failure to comply with the terms of this Order may result in sanctions, <u>up to and including entry of default and termination of a water right claim or dismissal of objections</u>. Rule 22, W.R.Adj.R.

Nothing was filed.

PRINCIPLES AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The Water Court must address all issue remarks decreed on a claim. Section 85-2-248, MCA.
- 2. A properly filed Statement of Claim for an existing water right is prima facie proof of its content. Section 85-2-227, MCA. This prima facie validity may be overcome by evidence showing that one or more elements of the claim are incorrect. This standard of proof applies to objectors or claimants objecting to their own water right claims. Rule 19, W.R.Adj.R., *Nelson v. Brooks*, 2014 MT 120; 375 Mont.86, 95; 329 P.3d 558, 564.

3. Pursuant to Rule 22, W.R.Adj.R., if a claimant, objector, or intervenor fails to appear at a scheduled conference or hearing or fails to comply with an order issued by the Water Court, the Water Court may issue such orders of sanction with regard thereto as are just.

RECOMMENDATIONS

- 1. Claims 41S 28848-00 and 41S 140042-00 should be modified as shown in Finding of Fact No. 7.
- 2. The issue remarks should be removed from claims 41S 28848-00, 41S 139599-00, and 41S 140042-00.
