MASTER'S REPORT

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. David J. Garman, Nicole E. Garman, and Trevor Garman (the Garmans) are the record owners of claim 39F 30139260.
 - 2. Claim 39F 30139260 was decreed with DNRC issue remarks:

THIS CLAIM NUMBER WAS NOT INCLUDED IN THE BASIN 39F DECREE ISSUED 05/23/2019.

NO TYPE OF HISTORICAL RIGHT WAS CLAIMED. DOCUMENTATION TO SUPPORT THE TYPE OF HISTORICAL RIGHT WAS NOT SUBMITTED WITH THIS CLAIM.

All issue remarks must be addressed.

3. A deadline was set for the Garmans to address the type of historical right issue remark decreed on claim 39F 30139260. (Doc. 11.00). On June 27, 2024, the Garmans filed a Notice of Objection and Request for Hearing form for Basin 39F. The Objection period in Basin 39F closed on January 23, 2024. It appeared the Garmans intended the June 27, 2024 filing to be a response to the May 28, 2024 Order Setting Filing Deadline and it was taken as a response to the Order Setting Filing Deadline rather than an objection.

The June 27, 2024 filing indicated the following:

Pursuant to the attached patents, the priority date should be changed to June 8, 1911.

Claimants agree that the claim is a "Use" right:

Ten homestead patents were attached to the June 27, 2024 filing – the earliest dated June 3, 1914, and the latest dated June 28, 1939. A marked abstract attached to the June 27, 2024 filing suggests points of diversion and places of use may be related to the various patents. However, it was unclear how the Garmans determined that the proposed priority date for claim 39F 30139260 should be modified to June 8, 1914.

4. Another deadline was set for the Garmans to file evidence substantiating the priority date for claim 39F 30139260. (Doc. 4.00). The Order indicated that if nothing were filed by the deadline, this Water Master would conclude that the Garmans agree

claim 39F 30139260 is a "use" right with a June 28, 1939 priority date (the latest patent submitted into the record).

- 5. On August 16, 2024, the Garmans moved for the Court to adopt the June 28, 1939 priority date for claim 39F 30139260. (Doc. 5.00).
- 6. A deadline was set for the Garmans to file additional evidence showing stock use on the place of use appurtenant to claim 39F 30139260 as of June 28, 1939. (Doc. 6.00).
- 7. On September 23, 2024, the Garmans filed a Motion to Adopt the June 28, 1939 priority date along with the Affidavit of Shane Garman. (Docs. 7.00 and 8.00). The Affidavit states the following, in part:
 - 4. As a teenager, affiant worked for Danny Oliver who was the principal in Oliver Livestock Company. Oliver Livestock Company acquired this property from the Ball family whose patriarch was Ellis Ball who took title under a patent dated June 8, 1914 which is attached hereto as Exhibit A. Shelby Ball, another Ball family member took title to portions of the property by separate patents dated June 3, 1914 and December 3, 1915 and January 5, 1917, Exhibits B, C, & D hereto.

The Oliver family referred to this property as the "Ball place". Affiant personally knew Danny Oliver who was the child of Joe Oliver who acquired the property from the Ball family.

Affiant worked for Danny Oliver from 1985-1993 and was a pall bearer at Danny's funeral. During this time he became familiar with the Oliver family history on this particular land and, in turn, the water on it. Specifically, Joe Oliver was one of the first in the Oliver family to own the land in the 1920's or 30's. The Oliver family ran sheep, horses, and cattle on this land for the entirety of their ownership.

(Doc. 8.00, pg. 2).

PRINCIPLES AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The issue remarks were not addressed through the objection process. The Water Court is required to resolve the issues raised by each issue remark. Section 85-2-248, MCA. Under Section 85-2-248(3), MCA, information in the claim file or other information obtained by the Court can be reviewed to determine if it provides a sufficient

basis to resolve the issue raised by a remark and the Court can provide the claimant an opportunity to file additional information or evidence.

2. A properly filed Statement of Claim for an existing water right is prima facie proof of its content. Section 85-2-227, MCA. This prima facie validity may be overcome by evidence showing that one or more elements of the claim are incorrect. This standard of proof applies to objectors or claimants objecting to their own water right claims. Rule 19, W.R.Adj.R., *Nelson v. Brooks*, 2014 MT 120; 375 Mont.86, 95; 329 P.3d 558, 564.

Shane Garman has sworn that claim 39F 30139260 has been used continually for stock purposes since the early 1900s. It is appropriate to modify the claim based on the information provided.

3. The issue remark indicating claim 39F 30139260 was not included in the 2019 decree in Basin 39F is a notice-type remark. As no objections were filed, no further proceedings are required.

RECOMMENDATIONS

- 1. Claim 39F 30139260 should be a "use" right and the priority date should be modified to June 28, 1939.
 - 2. The issue remarks should be removed from claim 41S 30139260.

An abstract is enclosed for review.
