MASTER'S REPORT

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Jo Anne Roos and Shirley L. Brown (the Claimants) are the record owners of claims 41S 134167-00, 41S 134168-00, 41S 134169-00, and 41S 134170-00
- 2. Claims 41S 134167-00, 41S 134168-00, 41S 134169-00, and 41S 134170-00 were decreed with DNRC issue remarks:

41S 134167-00:

- FLOW RATE MAY REQUIRE MODIFICATION BASED ON RESOLUTION OF MAXIMUM ACRES ISSUE.
- THE FERGUS COUNTY WATER RESOURCES SURVEY(1970)APPEARS TO INDICATE 9.00 ACRES IRRIGATED. A DESCRIPTION OF THESE ACRES IS IN THE CLAIM FILE.
- USDA AERIAL PHOTOGRAPH NO(S). 30027-278-185, DATED 09/25/1979, AND 30027-178-63, DATED 09/18/1979, APPEARS TO INDICATE 0.00 ACRES IRRIGATED.


- DIVERSION MEANS WAS MODIFIED AS A RESULT OF DNRC REVIEW UNDER MONTANA WATER COURT REEXAMINATION ORDERS. IF NO OBJECTIONS ARE FILED TO THIS CLAIM, THESE ELEMENTS WILL REMAIN AS THEY APPEAR ON THIS ABSTRACT AND THE REMARK WILL BE REMOVED FROM THE CLAIM.
- 3. The Claimants were ordered to meet with the DNRC to address the place of use/maximum acres and flow rate issue remarks.
- 4. DNRC Water Resource Specialist Brandon Ahlgren filed a Memorandum stating Claimants Shirley Brown and Jo Anne Roos contacted the DNRC, and he met

with Ms. Brown. (Doc.¹ 3.00). Mr. Ahlgren indicated he reviewed scanned claim files and a Fergus County Water Resource Survey aerial photo to prepare the Memorandum. Proposed abstracts and a map were attached to the Memorandum.

5. Claims 41S 134167-00 and 41S 134168-00: Mr. Ahlgren identified 9.00 acres as irrigated at the claimed place of use for claims 41S 134167-00 and 41S 134168-00 and he stated "The claimant was unable to supply any evidence to substantiate more acreage than what was identified during examination." Mr. Ahlgren recommended the place of use be modified to 9.00 acres and the flow rate be reduced accordingly for both claims:



6. **Claim 41S 134169-00:** Mr. Ahlgren identified 12.90 acres as irrigated at the claimed place of use for claim 41S 134169-00. Mr. Ahlgren recommended the place of use be modified to 12.90 acres and the flow rate be reduced accordingly:



7. An Order was issued to determine if Claimants Jo Anne Roos and Shirley Brown agreed with the modifications proposed by Mr. Ahlgren. The Order indicated that if nothing were filed by the deadline, this Water Master would conclude the Claimants agreed with the proposed modifications. The following language was included in the Order:

Failure to comply with the terms of this Order may result in sanctions, <u>up to and including entry of default and termination of a water right claim or dismissal of objections</u>. Rule 22, W.R.Adj.R.

Nothing was filed.

PRINCIPLES AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The Water Court must address all issue remarks decreed on a claim. Section 85-2-248, MCA.
- 2. A properly filed Statement of Claim for an existing water right is prima facie proof of its content. Section 85-2-227, MCA. This prima facie validity may be overcome by evidence showing that one or more elements of the claim are incorrect. This standard of proof applies to objectors or claimants objecting to their own water right claims. Rule 19, W.R.Adj.R., *Nelson v. Brooks*, 2014 MT 120; 375 Mont.86, 95; 329 P.3d 558, 564.
- 3. The issue remarks decreed on claims 41S 134167-00 and 41S 134168-00 indicating the "maximum combined acres for this group of supplemental claims may require modification..." is not relevant because supplemental rights remarks on claims no longer include a quantified acreage figure.
- 4. The means of diversion issue remark decreed on claim 41S 134170-00 is a notice-type remark and has served its purpose. It can be removed.

RECOMMENDATIONS
