MASTER'S REPORT

The claims in this case are owned by Kimpton Ranch Co. ("Kimpton") and appeared in the Preliminary Decree for Basin 41E with issue remarks and received objections from USA Bureau of Land management ("BLM").

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. On August 15, 2024 Parties BLM and Kimpton submitted a Stipulation ("Stipulation")¹.
- 2. Claims 41E 100238-00, 41E 100241-00, 41E 100265-00 are stock claims from unnamed tributaries of Boulder River and Rogers Spring. The parties agree that the legal land descriptions of the places of use needs further refinement.
 - 3. The place of use for Claim 41E 100238-00 should be clarified as follows:

diversion and reservoir record were modified by DNRC. No objections were filed to these elements so the remark should be removed.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. A properly filed Statement of Claim for Existing Water Right is prima facie proof of its content. Section 85-2-227, MCA. This prima facie proof may be contradicted and overcome by other evidence that proves, by a preponderance of the evidence, that an element of the prima facie claim is incorrect. This is the burden of proof for every assertion that a claim is incorrect. Rule 19, W.R.Adj.R.
- 2. The degree or weight of evidence needed to contradict or overcome the prima facie proof statute is a preponderance of the evidence. *Burkhartsmeyer et al. v. Burkhartsmeyer et al.*, Case 40G-2, (MT Water Court Memorandum Opinion and Order Adopting Master's Report, Mar. 11, 1997). The Montana Supreme Court has defined preponderance as "a relatively modest standard that the statutory criteria are 'more probable than not' to have been met." *Hohenlohe v. State*, 2010 MT 203 ¶ 33, 357 Mont. 438, 240 P.3d 628.
- 3. The Montana Water Court is permitted to use information submitted by the Department of Natural Resources and Conservation, the statement of claim, information from approved compacts, and any other data obtained by the Court to evaluate water right claims. Section 85-2-231(2), MCA.
- 4. When resolving issue remarks, the Montana Water Court must weigh the information resulting in the issue remark and the issue remark against the claimed water right. Section 85-2-247(2), MCA.
- 5. If a claimant agrees to reduce or limit an element of a claim, the Water Court does not need to determine whether the burden of proof has been met. The Water Court may accept a claimant's requested reduction or limitation without further presentation of evidence. Rule 17(c) W.R.Adj.R.
- 6. The evidence entered into the record is sufficient to make the changes to the claims' places of use.

RECOMMENDATIONS

Based upon the above Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, this Master recommends the Court make the changes specified above to correct the Preliminary Decree for this Basin.

Post Decree Abstracts of Water Right Claims are served with this Report to confirm the recommended corrections have been made in the state's centralized record system.
