MASTER'S REPORT

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Monte J. Boettger, Wade R. Boettger, and West G. Boettger (the Boettgers) are the record owners of claim 41S 115262-00.
 - 2. Claim 41S 115262-00 was decreed with DNRC issue remarks:

FLOW RATE MAY REQUIRE MODIFICATION BASED ON RESOLUTION OF MAXIMUM ACRES ISSUE.

THE CLAIMANT DID NOT IDENTIFY THE PERIOD OF DIVERSION FOR THIS RIGHT. A PERIOD OF DIVERSION HAS BEEN ADDED TO MATCH THE PERIOD OF USE. IF NO OBJECTIONS ARE RECEIVED TO THE PERIOD OF DIVERSION OR PERIOD OF USE, THOSE ELEMENTS WILL BE DECREED AS SHOWN ON THIS ABSTRACT AND THIS ISSUE REMARK WILL BE REMOVED FROM THIS CLAIM.

RESERVOIR RECORD WAS MODIFIED AS A RESULT OF DNRC REVIEW UNDER MONTANA WATER COURT REEXAMINATION ORDERS. IF NO OBJECTIONS ARE FILED TO THIS CLAIM, THESE ELEMENTS WILL REMAIN AS THEY APPEAR ON THIS ABSTRACT AND THE REMARK WILL BE REMOVED FROM THE CLAIM.

THE FERGUS COUNTY WATER RESOURCES SURVEY (1970) APPEARS TO INDICATE 8.00 ACRES IRRIGATED. A DESCRIPTION OF THESE ACRES IS IN THE CLAIM FILE.

USDA AERIAL PHOTOGRAPH NO(S). 30027-278-18 , DATED 09/25/1979 , APPEARS TO INDICATE 0.00 ACRES IRRIGATED.

- 3. The Boettgers were ordered to meet with a DNRC employee to address the place of use and flow rate issue remarks decreed on claim 41S 115262-00.
- 3. DNRC Water Resource Specialist Carli Bluhm filed a Memorandum on July 22, 2024. (Doc.* 2.00). The Memorandum reports Ms. Bluhm met with the Claimants on June 13, 2024. Ms. Bluhm indicated she reviewed the abstract, information in the claim file, the Fergus County and Judith Basin County Water Resources Surveys, and an aerial photograph to prepare the Memorandum; a map and proposed abstract were attached to the Memorandum. Ms. Bluhm recommended claim 41S 115262-00 be modified as follows:

4. An Order was issued setting a deadline to determine if the Boettgers agreed or disagreed with the recommended modifications to claim 41S 115262-00. The Order indicated that if nothing were filed by the deadline, this Water Master would conclude the

Boettgers agreed with the recommended modifications. Nothing was filed by the August 30, 2024 deadline.

PRINCIPLES AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The Water Court must address all issue remarks decreed on a claim. Section 85-2-248, MCA.
- 2. A properly filed Statement of Claim for an existing water right is prima facie proof of its content. Section 85-2-227, MCA. This prima facie validity may be overcome by evidence showing that one or more elements of the claim are incorrect. This standard of proof applies to objectors or claimants objecting to their own water right claims. Rule 19, W.R.Adj.R., *Nelson v. Brooks*, 2014 MT 120; 375 Mont.86, 95; 329 P.3d 558, 564.
- 3. The period of diversion and reservoir record issue remarks decreed on claim 41S 115262-00 are notice-type remarks. As no objections were filed, no further proceedings are required because of the remarks.

RECOMMENDATIONS

- 1. Claim 41S 115262-00 should be changed as shown in Finding of Fact Number 3.
 - 2. The issue remarks should be removed from claim 41S 115262-00. An abstract is attached for review.
