This Master's Report was filed with the Montana Water Court on the above stamped date. Please review this report carefully.

You may file a written objection to this Master's Report within **10 days** of the stamped date if you disagree or find errors with the Master's findings of fact, conclusions of law, or recommendations. objection and a certificate of mailing to all parties on the service list must be filed with the Water Court.

If you do not file a timely objection, the Water Court will conclude that you agree with the content of this Master's Report.

MASTER'S REPORT

EOB Ranch LLC objected to each of these claims except 43B 23176-00. Claims 43B 23176-00, 43B 23209-00, 43B 23211-00, 43B 23212-00, 43B 23213-00, 43B 23214-00, 43B 23215-00, 43B 23217-00, and 43B 23219-00 have issue remarks.

The Legislature has directed the Water Court to resolve the issue remarks using the procedures set forth in section 85-2-248, MCA.

Under Section 85-2-248(2), MCA, information in the claim file or other information obtained by the Court can be reviewed to determine if it provides a sufficient basis to resolve the issue raised by a remark. In this instance, the information in the claim files was not sufficient but additional information has been obtained by the Court which addresses and resolves the issue remarks. The July 26, 2023 Order Denying Motion For Extension and Order Setting Filing Deadlines Pursuant To Section 85-2-248(5), MCA set deadlines in September 2023 for the claimant and the Montana Department of Natural Resources and Conservation ["DNRC"] to file documentation addressing and resolving the issue remarks. On October 16, 2023 the DNRC Memorandum was filed making recommendations for some of the issue remarks. On March 29, 2024 EOB Ranch LLC filed a Proposal To Resolve Objections And Issue Remarks And Motion For Implied Claims and the Affidavit Of Eleanor Molzahn. On July 9, 2024 EOB Ranch LLC filed the Affidavit Of Joshua E. Fjare providing additional information. These settlement documents are viewable in the Court's FullCourt Enterprise case management system.

APPLICABLE LAW

"All issue remarks to claims that are not resolved through the filing of an objection as provided in 85-2-233 must be resolved as provided in this section." Section 85-2-248(2), MCA. "Implied Claim' means a claim authorized by the water court to be separated and individually identified when a statement of claim includes multiple rights." Rule 2(a)(33), W.R.C.E.R.

From 41P-108 "Circle S Ranch, Inc." Order On Motion To Modify Claims 5-16-19, at 2019 Mont. Water LEXIS 8, page 5:

The Water Court recognizes implied claims in certain circumstances *In re Musselshell River below Roundup*, Case 40C-47, 1994 Mont. Water LEXIS 18, *78 (July 14, 1994). However, before the Court will recognize an implied claim, the claimant must prove that several factors exist. These include: (1) proof of two or more water rights in the original claim form or the material submitted with the claim form; (2) proof of historic use corroborating the implied claim; and (3) proof that recognizing the implied claim(s) will avoid causing a change to historic water use or increase the historic burden to other water users. *In re Foss*, Case 76HF-580, 2013 Mont. Water LEXIS 17, *32 (Jan. 31, 2013); *In re Martinell*, Case 41A-148, 2018 Mont. Water LEXIS 3, *6 (June 14, 2018). These standards assure that implied claims are not used to revive a claim that was forfeited as a matter of law by missing the filing deadline. Mont. Code Ann. § 85-2-226 (establishing conclusive presumption of abandonment of for claims not timely filed); *In re Climbing Arrow Ranch*, Case 41F-A19, 2019 Mont. Water LEXIS 1 (Mar. 6, 2019). The implied claim process also cannot be used to expand the elements of a statement of claim. *In re Eliasson Ranch Company*, Order Amending and Adopting Master’s Report, Case 40A-115, 2004 Mont. Water LEXIS 2, *6 (Jun. 28, 2004) (“*Eliasson*”).

A properly filed Statement of Claim for Existing Water Right is prima facie proof of its content pursuant to section 85-2-227, MCA. This prima facie proof may be contradicted and overcome by other evidence that proves, by a preponderance of the evidence, that the elements of the claim do not accurately reflect the beneficial use of the water right as it existed prior to July 1, 1973. This is the burden of proof for every assertion that a claim is incorrect including for claimants objecting to their own claims. Rule 19, W.R.Adj.R.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Claim 43B 23176-00 appeared in the Preliminary Decree with the following issue remark:

THE LEGAL LAND DESCRIPTION FOR POINTS OF DIVERSION NO. 8 AND 10 COULD NOT BE REFINED FROM INFORMATION IN THE FILE. THE CLAIMED POINTS OF DIVERSION CANNOT BE CONFIRMED.

The settlement states that the points of diversion are on Lower Deer Creek and three different unnamed tributaries of Lower Deer Creek, and requests generation of an implied claim for each of the unnamed tributaries.

2. A review of the Statement of Claim and its attachments shows that points of diversion from these four sources and their correlative places of use were combined as a single claim.

3. Claim 43B 23176-00 should be used for the Lower Deer Creek diversions. Implied

claims 43B 30160082, 43B 30160083, and 43B 30160084 should be used for each of the unnamed tributary diversions.

4. For claim 43B 23176-00, the Preliminary Decree states that the point of diversion and place of use are:

5. The elements of implied claim 43B 30160082 should be the same as 43B 23176-00 except the source should be UNNAMED TRIBUTARY OF LOWER DEER CREEK, and the point of diversion and place of use should be:

8. For claim 43B 23209-00, the settlement states the objection is withdrawn.

This claim appeared in the Preliminary Decree with the following notice remark:

POINT OF DIVERSION MODIFIED AS A RESULT OF DNRC REVIEW UNDER MONTANA WATER COURT REEXAMINATION ORDERS. IF NO OBJECTIONS ARE FILED TO THIS CLAIM, THESE ELEMENTS WILL REMAIN AS THEY APPEAR ON THIS ABSTRACT AND THE REMARK WILL BE REMOVED FROM THE CLAIM.

The remark does not raise an unresolved issue which needs to be addressed. There are no proceedings required for this remark. The remark should be removed as having served its notice purpose.

9. For claim 43B 23210-00, the Preliminary Decree states that the flow rate is 2.88 CFS. The flow rate should be 3.85 CFS as originally claimed.

The Preliminary Decree states that the place of use is:

10. For claim 43B 23211-00, the Preliminary Decree states the flow rate is 341.09 GPM. The flow rate should be 1.00 CFS as originally claimed.

This claim appeared in the Preliminary Decree with the following issue remark:

THE CLAIMED POINT OF DIVERSION IS IN QUESTION. THE LOCATION OF THE HEADGATE CANNOT BE IDENTIFIED FROM AVAILABLE DATA.

The settlement states that the headgate is located at the point of diversion legal description.

11. For claim 43B 23212-00, the Preliminary Decree states the flow rate is 2.27 CFS.

The flow rate should be 5.00 CFS as originally claimed.

This claim appeared in the Preliminary Decree with the following notice remarks:

THE PRIORITY DATE MAY BE QUESTIONABLE. THIS CLAIM IS FOR A FILED RIGHT ON LOWER DUCK CREEK WITH A PRIORITY DATE PREDATING CASE NO 315, SWEET GRASS COUNTY. IF NO OBJECTIONS ARE FILED TO PRIORITY DATE OR TYPE OF HISTORICAL RIGHT, THESE ELEMENTS WILL BE DECREED AS SHOWN ON THIS ABSTRACT AND THIS REMARK WILL BE REMOVED.

POINT OF DIVERSION MODIFIED AS A RESULT OF DNRC REVIEW UNDER MONTANA WATER COURT REEXAMINATION ORDERS. IF NO OBJECTIONS ARE FILED TO THIS CLAIM, THESE ELEMENTS WILL REMAIN AS THEY APPEAR ON THIS ABSTRACT AND THE REMARK WILL BE REMOVED FROM THE CLAIM.

The remarks do not raise unresolved issues which need to be addressed. There are no proceedings required for these remarks. The remarks should be removed as having served their notice purposes.

12. For claim 43B 23213-00, the settlement states there are no changes to be made to the means of diversion and point of diversion.

The abstract of this claim includes the following notice remark:

POINT OF DIVERSION MODIFIED AS A RESULT OF DNRC REVIEW UNDER MONTANA WATER COURT REEXAMINATION ORDERS. IF NO OBJECTIONS ARE FILED TO THIS CLAIM, THESE ELEMENTS WILL REMAIN AS THEY APPEAR ON THIS ABSTRACT AND THE REMARK WILL BE REMOVED FROM THE CLAIM.

The remark does not raise an unresolved issue which needs to be addressed. There are no proceedings required for this remark. The remark should be removed as having served its notice purpose.

13. Claim 43B 23214-00 appeared in the Preliminary Decree with the following issue remarks:

THE CLAIMED FLOW RATE EXCEEDS THE 17 GPM PER ACRE GUIDELINE AND CANNOT BE CONFIRMED DUE TO LACK OF DATA. THE FLOW RATE EQUALS 70.00 GPM PER ACRE.

THE CLAIMED POINT OF DIVERSION IS IN QUESTION. THE LOCATION OF THE HEADGATE CANNOT BE IDENTIFIED FROM AVAILABLE DATA.

The settlement states that the flow rate does not require change. The flow rate issue remark should be removed as addressed and resolved.

The Preliminary Decree states that the point of diversion legal description is the SENESW section 22, T1S, R15E, SWEET GRASS and the ditch name is HOHENBERGER DITCH. The legal description should be the SWSWNW section 27, T1S, R15E, SWEET GRASS and the ditch name is BIRKELAND DITCH. The point of diversion issue remark should be removed as addressed and resolved.

14. Claim 43B 23215-00 appeared in the Preliminary Decree with the following issue remarks:

THE CLAIMED FLOW RATE EXCEEDS THE 17 GPM PER ACRE GUIDELINE AND CANNOT BE CONFIRMED DUE TO LACK OF DATA. THE FLOW RATE EQUALS 18.00 GPM PER ACRE.

THE CLAIMED POINT OF DIVERSION IS IN QUESTION. THE LOCATION OF THE HEADGATE CANNOT BE IDENTIFIED FROM AVAILABLE DATA.

The settlement states that the flow rate and the point of diversion do not require change.

The issue remarks should be removed as addressed and resolved.

15. Claim 43B 23217-00 appeared in the Preliminary Decree with the following issue remark:

THE CLAIMED FLOW RATE EXCEEDS THE 17 GPM PER ACRE GUIDELINE AND CANNOT BE CONFIRMED DUE TO LACK OF DATA. THE FLOW RATE EQUALS 45.00 GPM PER ACRE.

The settlement states that the flow rate does not require change. The flow rate issue remark should be removed as addressed and resolved.

The Preliminary Decree states that the maximum acres irrigated is 10.00 and the place of use is:

The Preliminary Decree states that the point of diversion legal description is the SWSWNW section 27, T1S, R15E, SWEET GRASS and the ditch name is BIRKELAND DITCH. The

legal description should be the NESENE section 33, T1S, R15E, SWEET GRASS and the ditch name should be HOOPER DITCH.

The abstract for this claim includes the following notice remark:

POINT OF DIVERSION AND DITCH NAME WERE MODIFIED AS A RESULT OF DNRC REVIEW UNDER MONTANA WATER COURT REEXAMINATION ORDERS. IF NO OBJECTIONS ARE FILED TO THIS CLAIM, THESE ELEMENTS WILL REMAIN AS THEY APPEAR ON THIS ABSTRACT AND THE REMARK WILL BE REMOVED FROM THE CLAIM.

The remark does not raise an unresolved issue which needs to be addressed. There are no proceedings required for this remark. The remark should be removed as having served its notice purpose.

16. For claim 43B 23219-00, the settlement states there are no changes to be made to the maximum acres, place of use, means of diversion, and pint off diversion.

The abstract of this claim includes the following notice remark:

DITCH NAME AND POINT OF DIVERSION WERE MODIFIED AS A RESULT OF DNRC REVIEW UNDER MONTANA WATER COURT REEXAMINATION ORDERS. IF NO OBJECTIONS ARE FILED TO THIS CLAIM, THESE ELEMENTS WILL REMAIN AS THEY APPEAR ON THIS ABSTRACT AND THE REMARK WILL BE REMOVED FROM THE CLAIM.

The remark does not raise an unresolved issue which needs to be addressed. There are no proceedings required for this remark. The remark should be removed as having served its notice purpose.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. Statement of Claim 43B 23176-00 and its attachments plus the settlement filed by the claimant are sufficient to generate the implied claims.

2. The settlement filed by the claimant is sufficient to contradict and overcome the prima facie claims and to resolve the issue remarks without evidentiary hearing. Sections 85-2-248(3) and (11), MCA.

RECOMMENDATIONS

Based upon the above Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, this Master recommends that the Court generate implied claims 43B 30160082, 43B 30160083, and 43B 30160084, and make the changes specified in the Findings of Fact to correct the Preliminary Decree for this Basin. A Post Decree Abstract of Water Right Claim for each claim is served with this Report

to confirm the recommended changes have been made in the state's centralized record system.
