If you file an objection, you must serve a copy of the objection to all parties on the service list found at the end of the Master's Report. The original objection and a certificate of mailing to all parties on the service list must be filed with the Water Court.

If you do not file a timely objection, the Water Court will conclude that you agree with the content of this Master's Report.

MASTER'S REPORT

Water right claim 41H 35461-00 appeared in the Preliminary Decree for the Gallatin River ("Basin 41H") with issue remarks resulting from pre-decree examination by the Department of Natural Resources and Conservation ("DNRC"). To address the

issue remarks, the Water Court consolidates the claim into case 41H-0936-R-2025. The claim received no objections or counterobjections or notices of intent to appear.

FINDINGS OF FACT

 Claim 41H 35461-00 has an issue remark which states:
THE TYPE OF HISTORICAL RIGHT, PRIORITY DATE, AND FLOW RATE MAY BE QUESTIONABLE. THE CLAIMS FOLLOWING THIS
STATEMENT USE THE SAME FILED APPROPRIATION TO DOCUMENT THE RIGHT. THE COMBINED FLOW RATE FOR THIS GROUP OF
CLAIMS EXCEEDS THE TOTAL OF THE ORIGINAL APPROPRIATION.
41H 35461-00, 41H 138701-00.

2. Claims 41H 35461-00 and 41H 138701-00 are filed rights based on the same Notice of Appropriation filed by William Perks on November 11, 1890.

3. Upon reviewing the Notice of Appropriation, each water right is claiming a separate portion of the Appropriation.

4. Claim 41H 138701-00 has already had the issue remark removed in a prior Water Court proceeding.

5. Claim 41H 35461-00 also has an issue remark stating THE CLAIMED PRIORITY DATE MAY BE QUESTIONABLE. THE PRIORITY DATE ON THE SUBMITTED NOTICE OF APPROPRIATION IS 11/11/1890.

6. No objection to the priority date was filed. The priority date on the preliminary decree abstract is 11/26/1890.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. A properly filed Statement of Claim for Existing Water Right is prima facie proof of its content. Section 85-2-227, MCA. This prima facie proof may be contradicted and overcome by other evidence that proves, by a preponderance of the evidence, that an element of the prima facie claim is incorrect. This is the burden of proof for every assertion that a claim is incorrect. Rule 19, W.R.Adj.R. A preponderance of the evidence is evidence that demonstrates the fact to be proved is "more probable than not." *Hohenlohe v. State*, 2010 MT 203, ¶33, 357 Mont. 348, 240 P.3d 628.

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2. The Montana Water Court may accept a reduction or limitation to an element of a claim and need not determine whether the burden of proof is met unless there is an unresolved issue remark on the claim. Rule 17(c), W.R.Adj.R.

3. The Montana Water Court is permitted to use information submitted by the Department of Natural Resources and Conservation, the statement of claim, information from approved compacts, and any other data obtained by the Court to evaluate water right claims. Section 85-2-231(2), MCA.

4. When resolving issue remarks, the Montana Water Court must weigh the information resulting in the issue remark and the issue remark against the claimed water right. Section 85-2-247(2), MCA.

5. The Montana Water Court has the authority to resolve issue remarks when the claim file and information available to the Court provide a sufficient basis to do so. Section 85-2-248(3), MCA.

RECOMMENDATIONS

Based upon the foregoing, all issue remarks appearing on the claims should be removed as they have been resolved. Post Decree Abstracts of Water Right Claim are served with this Report to confirm that the modifications and dismissal recommended have been made in the state's centralized record system.
