MASTER'S REPORT

Statement of the case

John P. Scully and Antoinette C. Scully ("Scullys") stock claim 41F 30125945 appeared in the Preliminary Decree with the following issue remark:

THIS CLAIM NUMBER WAS NOT INCLUDED IN THE BASIN 41F DECREE ISSUED 07/25/1984.

Issue remarks most often result from Department of Natural Resources and Conservation ("DNRC") claims examination. An issue remark may simply provide notice to water users concerning a claim, as does the above noted issue remark.

The claim received a self-objection from Scullys stating, "The original claim form indicates that the source of this stockwater right is actually comprised of two sources: 1) O'Dell Creek, and 2) an Undeveloped Spring, tributary to O'Dell Creek. The preliminary decree states that the source is O'Dell Creek. An implied water right claim for stockwater use should be decreed by the Water Court recognizing the Undeveloped Spring source that is part of the claimed right."

PN Madison, LLC filed a notice of intent to appear for the claim.

Montana law requires the Water Court to resolve issue remarks, objections, and notices of intent to appear.

Scullys, by and through counsel of record, Michael J. L. Cusick, filed a Motion Requesting Addition of Source Name Clarification Remark. PN Madison, LLC did not oppose the motion.

Issues

- 1. Should the source name clarification remark be added to the claim, thereby resolving the objection to and notice of intent to appear for the claim?
 - 2. Is the notice issue remark on the claim resolved?

Finding of fact

A source name clarification remark should be added to stock claim 41F 30125945 stating:

THE SOURCE ALSO INCLUDES AN UNDEVELOPED SPRING TRIBUTARY TO O'DELL CREEK LOCATED IN THE E2SWNE OF SECTION 34, T5S, R1W MADISON COUNTY.

Principles of law

- 1. A properly filed Statement of Claim for Existing Water Right is prima facie proof of its content. Section 85-2-227, MCA.
- 2. The Montana Water Court is permitted to use information submitted by the Department of Natural Resources and Conservation, the statement of claim, information from approved compacts, and any other data obtained by the Court to evaluate water right claims. Section 85-2-231(2), MCA.
- 3. Settlement is subject to review and approval by the Water Court. Rule 17(a), W.R.Adj.R.
- 4. When resolving issue remarks, the Montana Water Court must weigh the information resulting in the issue remark and the issue remark against the claimed water right. Section 85-2-247(2), MCA.
- 5. The Montana Water Court has the authority to resolve issue remarks when the claim file and information available to the Court provide a sufficient basis to do so. Section 85-2-248(3), MCA.
- 6. The Water Court may add clear and unambiguous information remarks to a claim abstract that describe historical use and reduce the possibility of future conflict. *See Clark Fork Coalition v. Hirsch*, 2014 Mont. Water LEXIS 15 at **10-14 (Oct. 29, 2014).

Analysis

Issue 1 – source name clarification remark; resolution of objection and notice of intent to appear

Scullys assert the source names identified by statement of claim 41F 30125945 are historically accurate. Stock statement of claim 41F 30125945 identified two sources — O'Dell Creek and an undeveloped spring. Scullys proposed adding a source name

clarification remark instead of generating an implied claim for the undeveloped spring. The source names should match those identified by the prima facie statement of claim.

Scullys' Motion and a map depicting the two sources may be viewed on the court's case management system, FullCourt Enterprise, at document sequence 2.00.

Conclusions of law

The source name clarification remark is supported by prima facie statement of claim 41F 30125945. The source name clarification remark describes historical use and reduces the possibility of future conflict.

The record before the court justifies the modification proposed by Scullys and resolves their objection to the claim, and resolves PN Madison, LLC's notice of intent to appear for the claim.

Issue 2 – issue remark resolution

Stock claim 41F 30125945 appeared in the Preliminary Decree with the following issue remark:

THIS CLAIM NUMBER WAS NOT INCLUDED IN THE BASIN 41F DECREE ISSUED 07/25/1984.

The foregoing issue remark provided the opportunity for water users to object to the claim. The only objection to and notice of intent to appear for the claim are resolved by these proceedings.

Conclusion of law

The issue remark appearing on the claim served its notice purpose.

Recommendations

Stock claim 41F 30125945 should be modified as follows to accurately reflect historical use.

ADD SOURCE NAME CLARIFICATION REMARK:

THE SOURCE ALSO INCLUDES AN UNDEVELOPED SPRING TRIBUTARY TO O'DELL CREEK LOCATED IN THE E2SWNE OF SECTION 34, T5S, R1W MADISON COUNTY.

The notice issue remark should be removed from the claim abstract.

A Post Decree Abstract of Water Right Claim accompanies this report to confirm implementation of the recommendations in the state's centralized water right record system.
