Rule 23, W.R.Adj.R. If the Master's Report was mailed to you, the Montana Rules of Civil Procedure allow an additional 3 days be added to the 10-day objection period. Rule 6(d), M.R.Civ.P. If you file an objection, you must serve a copy of the objection to all parties on the service list found at the end of the Master's Report. The original objection and a certificate of mailing to all parties on the service list must be filed with the Water Court.

If you do not file a timely objection, the Water Court will conclude that you agree with the content of this Master's Report.

### **MASTER'S REPORT**

Claim 76N 133358-00 appeared in the Preliminary Decree for the Clark Fork River Below the Flathead River Basin (Basin 76N) issued September 21, 2023. Leroy K. Lueb and Willina C. Lueb own the claim. The claim received objections from the United States, DOA Forest Service (United States). The claim did not receive issue remarks.

### FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Claim 76N 133358-00 was decreed as a domestic claim that diverts water from Goat Creek in the S2NWSW of Section 5, T21N, R28W, Sanders County. The claim was decreed for use on 1.00 acres in the S2S2SW of Section 5, T21N, R28W, Sanders County.
  - 2. The United States objected to the point of diversion, stating:

The point of diversion, as described, incorrectly includes National Forest System land. Point of Diversion No. 1 should be corrected to <a href="SWSW">SWSW</a> Section 5, Township 21N, Range 28W, Sanders County.

- 3. On April 22, 2025, the United States filed a Stipulation to Resolve Objections (Stipulation) entered into between the United States and Claimants. (Doc. <sup>1</sup> 5.00). The Stipulation proposed minor clarifying modifications to the place of use. The requested modifications resolve the United States' objection.
  - 4. The place of use for the claim should be amended as follows:

# PRINCIPLES OF LAW

- 1. A properly filed Statement of Claim for an existing water right is prima facie proof of its content. Section 85-2-227, MCA; Rule 10, W.R.Adj.R.
- 2. Prima facie proof may be contradicted and overcome by a preponderance of the evidence. Rule 19, W.R.Adj.R.

- 3. A preponderance of the evidence is evidence that shows a fact is "more probable than not." *Hohenlohe v. State*, 2010 MT 203, ¶ 33, 357 Mont. 438, 240 P.3d 628.
- 4. If prima facie status is overcome, the burden shifts back to the claimant to demonstrate historical use. *79 Ranch v. Pitsch*, 204 Mont. 426, 432-33, 666 P.2d 215, 218 (1983).
- 5. The Water Court may use information submitted by the DNRC, the Statement of Claim, and any other data obtained by the Court to evaluate a water right. Sections 85-2-227, -231(2), MCA.
- 6. If a claimant agrees to reduce or limit a claim, the Water Court may accept the reduction or limitation without reviewing further evidence, unless an unresolved issue remark remains. Rule 17(c), W.R.Adj.R.
- 7. The party seeking to overcome the prima facie status of a Statement of Claim bears the burden of proof; this burden also applies to a claimant's objection to his own claim. *Nelson v. Brooks*, 2014 MT 120, ¶¶ 34, 37, 375 Mont. 86, 329 P.3d 558.
- 8. The Water Court is not bound by parties' settlement agreements. Any settlement reached by the parties is subject to review and approval by the Water Court. Rule 17(a), W.R.Adj.R.

# **CONCLUSION OF LAW**

1. The Stipulation entered into between the United States and Claimants overcomes the prima facie status of claim 76N 133358-00. Evidence in the Stipulation suggests that the place of use modification should be made and the information remark regarding the ownership of the property on which the point of diversion and place of use are located should be added.

# RECOMMENDATIONS

1. Claim 76N 133358-00 should be amended to reflect the place of use agreed upon in the Stipulation:

2. The following information remark should be added to the claim abstract for claim 76N 133358-00:
