MASTER'S REPORT

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Claimants Billy D. Butler, Gary D. Butler, Karla Butler, and Tommy D.

Butler (the Butlers) were ordered to meet with a DNRC employee to address the

following unresolved issue remarks decreed on claims 41S 135207-00 and 41S 135208-

00:

41S 135207-00 and 41S 135208-00:

- FLOW RATE MAY REQUIRE MODIFICATION BASED ON RESOLUTION OF MAXIMUM ACRES ISSUE.
- THIS CLAIM PRESENTS ISSUES OF FACT AND LAW THAT MAY BE ADDRESSED AT THE OBJECTION STAGE. IT APPEARS THAT 0 ACRES ARE ACTUALLY IRRIGATED AND PROBLEMS COULD EXIST WITH FLOW RATE AND VOLUME.
- THE FERGUS COUNTY WATER RESOURCES SURVEY (1970) APPEARS TO INDICATE 0.00 ACRES IRRIGATED.
- USDA AERIAL PHOTOGRAPH NO(S). 30027-278-212 , DATED 09/25/1979 , APPEARS TO INDICATE 0.00 ACRES IRRIGATED.
- THE POINTS OF DIVERSION MAY BE INCORRECT. THE LOCATIONS OF THE HEADGATES CANNOT BE IDENTIFIED FROM AVAILABLE DATA.

2. DNRC Water Resource Specialist Carli Bluhm filed a Memorandum stating

"the DNRC met with one claimant on September 19, 2024." (Doc.¹ 4.00). The

Memorandum did not indicate with whom the DNRC met. Ms. Bluhm indicated that she

reviewed abstracts, the Fergus County Water Resource Survey, and an aerial photo to

prepare the Memorandum. Photos were attached to the Memorandum.

- **41S 135207-00:** Ms. Bluhm reported that the Claimant told the DNRC that "there was a ditch at one point, but the tubing and ditch was moved." Ms. Bluhm did not find evidence of irrigation and recommended claim 41S 135207-00 be dismissed.
- **41S 135208-00:** Ms. Bluhm reported that the Claimant explained that there are 4.00 acres of irrigation on the NENESW of Section 24, T15N, R19E, but provided no historical evidence of that irrigation. This Water Master took this information to mean that the referenced 4.00 acres is present-day irrigation. Ms. Bluhm stated that the land is irrigable, but the aerial photo and the Fergus County Water Resources Survey do not support historical irrigation at the claimed place of use. Ms. Bluhm recommended claim 41S 135208-00 be dismissed.

3. A deadline was set to determine if Claimants Billy D. Butler, Gary D. Butler, Karla Butler, and Tommy D. Butler agreed or disagreed with the recommended dismissal of claims 41S 135207-00 and 41S 135208-00. On November 8, 2024, Tommy D. Butler, Karla Butler, and Billy D. Butler filed a statement:

Butler Case 41S0741-R-2024 415 135207-00 415 135208-00 We the claimants disagree with the proposed dismissal of the above claims. These claims were legally applied for, and filing fees were paid and water rights granted to our parents. New filing fees imposed by former Governor Schweitzer Administration have been paid, also taxes on the increased real estate values. Years of drought and lower snow fall amounts has made the use of these water rights without the proper infrastructure not usable. Ditches need to be retrenched. We ask that you do not deny the next future generation of right holders the use of these water rights. Sincerely Claimants, Gary D. Butler (Deceased)

4. As issue remarks implicating abandonment or nonperfection remained unresolved, the State of Montana, Attorney General was joined as a necessary party to these proceedings. (Doc. 6.00).

5. A Stipulation was filed on January 22, 2025 in which the parties agreed claims 41S 135207-00 and 41S 135208-00 have been abandoned and should be dismissed. (Doc. 7.00)

PRINCIPLES AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Water Court is required to resolve all issue remarks before a final decree. §85-2-247, MCA. Under §-85-2-248(6), MCA, when an issue remark cannot be resolved through an informal meeting between the claimant and the DNRC, the Water Court must schedule proceedings to address and resolve the remark. These proceedings must include the DNRC. Section 85-2-248(7), MCA, requires joinder of the State of Montana, through the Attorney General, as a necessary party when the unresolved issues include nonperfection or abandonment.

2. A properly filed Statement of Claim for an existing water right is prima facie proof of its content. Section 85-2-227, MCA. This prima facie validity may be overcome by evidence showing that one or more elements of the claim are incorrect. This standard of proof applies to objectors or claimants objecting to their own water right claims. Rule 19, W.R.Adj.R., *Nelson v. Brooks*, 2014 MT 120; 375 Mont.86, 95; 329 P.3d 558, 564.

RECOMMENDATION

Claims 41S 135207-00 and 41S 135208-00 should be dismissed.
Abstracts are attached for review.
