MASTER'S REPORT

The United States, DOI Bureau of Indian Affairs objected each of these claims. On May 30, 2025 the parties filed a Stipulation to resolve the objections. The Stipulation is viewable in the Court's FullCourt Enterprise case management system.

APPLICABLE LAW

A properly filed Statement of Claim for Existing Water Right is prima facie proof of its content pursuant to section 85-2-227, MCA. This prima facie proof may be contradicted and overcome by other evidence that proves, by a preponderance of the evidence, that the elements of the claim do not accurately reflect the beneficial use of the water right as it existed prior to July 1, 1973. This is the burden of proof for every assertion that a claim is incorrect including for claimants objecting to their own claims. Rule 19, W.R.Adj.R.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. For claim 43O 30134982, the Interlocutory Decree states that the point of diversion legal description is the SWSESW section 21, T7S, R34E, BIG HORN. The legal description should be the NWSESW section 21, T7S, R34E, BIG HORN.

As requested in the Stipulation, the following legal description should be added to the place of use: SESWSW section 21, T7S, R34E, BIG HORN.

- 2. For claim 43O 30134983, as requested in the Stipulation, the following legal description should be added to the place of use: SESWSW section 21, T7S, R34E, BIG HORN.
 - 3. For each claim, the Interlocutory Decree includes the following remark:

THIS CLAIM NUMBER WAS NOT INCLUDED IN THE BASIN 430 DECREE ISSUED 03/25/2010. This remark provides notice that the claim was not included in the Preliminary Decree. The remark does not raise an unresolved issue which needs to be addressed. There are no proceedings required for this remark.

CONCLUSION OF LAW

The settlement filed by the parties is sufficient to contradict and overcome the prima facie claims.

RECOMMENDATIONS

Based upon the above Findings of Fact and Conclusion of Law, this Master recommends that the Court make the changes specified in the Findings of Fact to correct the Preliminary Decree for this Basin. A Post Decree Abstract of Water Right Claim for each claim is served with this Report to confirm the recommended changes have been made in the state's centralized record system.
