NOTICE OF FILING OF MASTER'S REPORT

This Master's Report was filed with the Montana Water Court on the above stamped date. Please review this report carefully.

You may file a written objection to this Master's Report within **10 days** of the stamped date if you disagree or find errors with the Master's findings of fact, conclusion of law, or recommendations. Rule 23, W.R.Adj.R. If the Master's Report was mailed to you, the Montana Rules of Civil Procedure allow an additional 3 days to be added to the 10-day objection period. Rule 6(d), M.R.Civ.P. If you file an objection, you must mail a copy of the objection to all parties on the service list found at the end of the Master's Report. The original objection and a certificate of mailing to all parties on the service list must be filed with the Water Court.

If you do not file a timely objection, the Water Court will conclude that you agree with the content of this Master's Report.

MASTER'S REPORT

The United States, DOA Forest Service objected to all elements on each of these Douglas E. Salsbury stock claims. On April 17, 2025 Claimant Douglas E. Salsbury's Motion To Amend Priority Date ["Motion"] was filed. As the priority for each claim is already at issue, this is a

generic motion to amend, not a motion to amend filed pursuant to section 85-2-233(6), MCA. The Moton states; "[T]he Objector, USFS, has reviewed the proposed reduction to priority date for each of these three claims and does not oppose the reduction, resolving its objection to the claims consolidated in this case." The Motion is viewable in the Court's FullCourt Enterprise case management system.

<u>APPLICABLE LAW</u>

A properly filed Statement of Claim for Existing Water Right is prima facie proof of its content pursuant to section 85-2-227, MCA. This prima facie proof may be contradicted and overcome by other evidence that proves, by a preponderance of the evidence, that the elements of the claim do not accurately reflect the beneficial use of the water right as it existed prior to July 1, 1973. This is the burden of proof for every assertion that a claim is incorrect including for claimants objecting to their own claims. Rule 19, W.R.Adj.R.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. For each of these use right claims, the Preliminary Decree states that the priority date is APRIL 1, 1885. The priority date should be JANUARY 11, 1912.
- 2. The Preliminary Decree also includes the following notice remark on each claim abstract:

THIS CLAIM NUMBER WAS NOT INCLUDED IN THE BASIN 41E DECREE ISSUED 06/20/1985.

There are no proceedings required for this remark. The remark should be removed from each abstract as having served its notice purpose.

CONCLUSION OF LAW

The unopposed Motion filed by the claimant is sufficient to contradict and overcome the prima facie claims.

RECOMMENDATIONS

Based upon the above Findings of Fact and Conclusion of Law, this Master recommends that the Court make the changes specified in the Findings of Fact to correct the Preliminary Decree for this Basin. A Post Decree Abstract of Water Right Claim for each claim is served with

this Report to confirm the recommended changes have been made in the state's centralized record system.
