MASTER'S REPORT

Statement of the case

Stock claims 41F 132622-00, 41F 132626-00, and 41F 132627-00 received self-objections from claimant T-L Irrigation Co. T-L Irrigation Co. objected to the point of diversion and place of use identified by claim 41F 132622-00 and the point of diversion identified by claims 41F 132626-00 and 41F 132627-00.

The claims also received the following issue remarks:

Issue remarks often result from Department of Natural Resources and Conservation ("DNRC") claims examination. Claims examination confirms the historical use of water right claims and identifies issues with claims.

Montana law requires the Water Court to resolve issue remarks and objections.

Issues

- 1. Are T-L Irrigation Co.'s objections to each claim resolved?
- 2. Are the issue remarks on each claim resolved?

Findings of fact

- 1. The historical point of diversion and place of use for livestock direct from source claim 41F 132622-00 parcel ID currently identified as No. 3 is the NESW of Section 31, Township 8 South, Range 1 West.
- 2. The historically accurate point of diversion for stock claims 41F 132626-00 and 41F 132627-00 is the NWNWSE of Section 28, Township 8 South, Range 1 West.

Principles of law

- 1. A properly filed Statement of Claim for Existing Water Right is prima facie proof of its content. Section 85-2-227, MCA. Prima facie proof may be overcome by other evidence that proves, by a preponderance of the evidence, that an element of the prima facie claim is incorrect. This is the burden of proof for every assertion that a claim is incorrect. Rule 19, W.R.Adj.R. A preponderance of the evidence is a "modest standard" and is evidence that demonstrates the fact to be proved is "more probable than not." *Hohenlohe v. State*, 2010 MT 203, ¶ 33, 357 Mont. 348, 240 P.3d 628.
- 2. The Montana Water Court is permitted to use information submitted by the Department of Natural Resources and Conservation, the statement of claim, information from approved compacts, and any other data obtained by the Court to evaluate water right claims. Section 85-2-231(2), MCA.
- 3. Settlement, including the documents filed by a claimant where the claimant is the only party, is subject to review and approval by the Water Court. Rule 17(a), W.R.Adj.R.
- 4. When resolving issue remarks, the Montana Water Court must weigh the information resulting in the issue remark and the issue remark against the claimed water right. Section 85-2-247(2), MCA.
- 5. The Montana Water Court has the authority to resolve issue remarks when the claim file and information available to the Court provide a sufficient basis to do so. Section 85-2-248(3), MCA.

Analysis

Issues 1 and 2 - Objection and issue remark resolution

T-L Irrigation Co.'s objection asserts the point of diversion and place of use identified by the map attached to and in support of stock statement of claim 41F 132622-00 is historically accurate.

T-L Irrigation Co.'s objections to stock claims 41F 132626-00 and 41F 132627-00 confirm the historical accuracy of the point of diversion identified by the issue remark on each claim.

Stock claim 41F 132626-00 appeared in the Preliminary Decree with the following issue remark:

DITCH NAME WAS MODIFIED AS A RESULT OF DNRC REVIEW UNDER MONTANA WATER COURT REEXAMINATION ORDERS. IF NO OBJECTIONS ARE FILED TO THIS CLAIM, THESE ELEMENTS WILL REMAIN AS THEY APPEAR ON THIS ABSTRACT AND THE REMARK WILL BE REMOVED FROM THE CLAIM.

The foregoing issue remark provided the opportunity for claimant and other water users to object to the claim. No one, including T-L Irrigation Co., objected to the ditch name issue remark on claim 41F 132626-00.

Conclusions of law

The modification to the point of diversion and place of use for stock claim 41F 132622-00 is a reduction within the parameters of the prima facie statement of claim and is supported by the map attached to and in support of the prima facie statement of claim. The record before the court justifies the modification proposed by T-L Irrigation Co.'s objection and resolves its objection to claim 41F 132622-00. The point of diversion issue remark on the claim is resolved.

The point of diversion issue remark, the information resulting in the issue remark, and T-L Irrigation Co.'s objection in agreement with the issue remark overcomes, by a preponderance of evidence, the prima facie proof afforded the point of diversion for claims 41F 132626-00 and 41F 132627-00. The point of diversion issue remark on each claim is resolved.

The Preliminary Decree abstract for stock claim 41F 132626-00 identifies the

historically accurate ditch name. The issue remark appearing on the claim served its notice purpose.

Recommendations

Stock claim 41F 132622-00 should be modified as follows to accurately reflect historical use.

The issue remarks should be removed from the claim abstracts.
