If you do not file a timely objection, the Water Court will conclude that you agree with the content of this Master's Report.

MASTER'S REPORT

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Claims 41H 138706-00, 41H 138708-00, 41H 138710-00, 41H 138711-00, 41H 30115292, and 41H 30115371 appeared in the Preliminary Decree for Basin 41H with Montana Department of Natural Resources and Conservation (DNRC) issue remarks. The claims received late objections from Terry Fluke.
- 2. On September 8, 1987, Terry Fluke filed an Objection to claims 41H 138708-00, 41H 138710-00, 41H 138711-00. The Objections were too late to be processed for the Basin 41H Temporary Preliminary Decree.
- 3. On December 23, 2024, the Court Consolidated the claims into this case and set a filing deadline for Terry Fluke to file state whether she would pursue the objections. The Court stated if nothing was filed, it would dismiss the objections and the claims would not change.
 - 4. No response was filed.
- 5. The late objection issue remarks on these claims can be removed and the Objections dismissed.
- 6. The remaining issue remarks on these claims are for notice purposes and can be removed.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The Montana Water Court has the authority to resolve issue remarks when the claim file and information available to the Court provide a sufficient basis to do so. Section 85-2-248(3), MCA.
- 2. A properly filed Statement of Claim for Existing Water Right is prima facie proof of its content. Section 85-2-227, MCA. This prima facie proof may be contradicted and overcome by other evidence that proves, by a preponderance of the evidence, that an element of the prima facie claim is incorrect. This is the burden of proof for every assertion that a claim is incorrect. Rule 19, W.R.Adj.R.
- 3. The degree or weight of evidence needed to contradict or overcome the prima facie proof statute is a preponderance of the evidence. *Burkhartsmeyer et al. v. Burkhartsmeyer et al.*, Case 40G-2, (MT Water Court Memorandum Opinion and Order Adopting Master's Report, Mar. 11, 1997). The Montana Supreme Court has defined preponderance as "a relatively modest standard that the statutory criteria are 'more probable than not' to have been met." *Hohenlohe v. State*, 2010 MT 203 ¶ 33, 357 Mont.

438, 240 P.3d 628.

- 4. The Montana Water Court is permitted to use information submitted by the Department of Natural Resources and Conservation, the statement of claim, information from approved compacts, and any other data obtained by the Court to evaluate water right claims. Section 85-2-231(2), MCA.
- 5. The issues raised by issue remarks must be resolved as part of the adjudication process pursuant to Section 85-2-248, MCA.
- 6. If a claimant or objector fails to comply with an order issued by the Water Court, the Court may, upon motion or its own initiative, issue such orders of sanction with regard thereto as are just. Rule 22, W.R.Adj.R.

<u>RECOMMENDATIONS</u>

Based upon the above Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, this Master recommends that the Court make the changes specified above to correct the Preliminary Decree for this Basin. Post Decree Abstracts of Water Right Claims are served with this Report to confirm that the recommended changes have been made in the state's centralized record system.
