NOTICE OF FILING OF MASTER'S REPORT

This Master's Report was filed with the Clerk of the Montana Water Court. <u>Please</u> review this Report carefully.

You may file a written objection to this Master's Report if you disagree or find errors with the Master's Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, or Recommendations. The above stamped date indicates the date this Master's Report was filed and mailed. Rule 23 of the Water Right Adjudication Rules requires written objections to a Master's Report be filed within 10 days of the date of the Master's Report. Because this Master's Report was mailed to you, Rule 6(d) of the Montana Rules of Civil Procedure provides an additional 3 days to the 10-day objection period.

If you file an objection, you must mail a copy of the objection to all parties on the Service List found at the end of this Master's Report. The original objection and a certificate of mailing to all parties on the Service List must be filed with the Water Court. If you do not file a timely objection, the Water Court will conclude that you agree with the content of this Master's Report.

MASTER'S REPORT

All water right claims that appeared in the Preliminary Decree for Sun River (Basin 41K) were subject to "issue remarks" resulting from pre-decree examination by the DNRC, objections, and counterobjections. The Claim United States Fish and Wildlife

Service filed an amendment to the Statement of Claim on October 9, 2020, and claim 41K 188174-00 also received issue remarks during the DNRC's review of the claims.

The claim is being consolidated into Case 41K-0708-R-2024 by the Water Court to resolve the amendment and issue remarks.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Claim 41K 188174-00 received the following substantive issue remarks: AN AMENDMENT WAS SUBMITTED ON 10/02/2020 REQUESTING TO AMEND THE POINT OF DIVERSION. THE AMENDMENT WAS NOT PROCESSED. THE THIS AMENDMENT WILL BE PROCESSED AFTER IT IS DECREED IN 41Q. THERE APPEARS TO BE A SECONDARY POINT OF DIVERSION IN THE NWNWSW SEC 27, T23N, R1E WHERE MUDDY CREEK WATER FLOWS OUT OF A PIPELINE AND INTO LAKE CREEK. THIS SECONDARY POINT OF DIVERSION IS LOCATED IN BASIN 41Q.

2. The amendment filed by the United States concurs with the proposed modification to the point of diversion shown in the above-listed issue remark and states the following requested modification to claim 41K 188174-00:

3. Claim 41K 188174-00 also received notice-type issue remarks from the DNRC during its claims reexamination. No objections were filed.

PRINCIPLES OF LAW

- 1. A properly filed Statement of Claim for an existing water right is prima facie proof of its content. Section 85-2-227, MCA; Rule 10, W.R.Adj.R.
- 2. Prima facie proof may be contradicted and overcome by a preponderance of the evidence. Rule 19, W.R.Adj.R.
- 3. A preponderance of the evidence is evidence that shows a fact is "more probable than not." *Hohenlohe v. State*, 2010 MT 203, ¶ 33, 357 Mont. 438, 240 P.3d 628.

- 4. Section 85-2-248(2), MCA, requires that the Water Court resolve all issue remarks that are not resolved through the objection process. *See also* Rule 7, W.R.Adj.R.
- 5. Notice is required to other water users if a motion to amend will adversely affect other water rights. Section 85-2-233(6), MCA.
- 6. A claimant asserting an amendment to its claim has the burden to show that the historical use of the claim is accurately reflected by the requested amendment. *Nelson v. Brooks*, 2014 MT 120, ¶ 34, 375 Mont. 86, 329 P.3d 558.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The information in the record resolves issue remarks appearing on claim 41K 188174-00. Based on the information presented in the amendment filed by the United States, a preponderance of the evidence shows that the point of diversion for claim 41K 188174-00 should be modified as described in Finding of Fact No. 2, and the substantive issue remarks should be removed from the claim.
- 2. The requested amendment and modification do not have the reasonable potential to adversely affect other water rights as they are a correction to the abstract which does not make any change to the actual historical use of the claimed right on the ground. Notice by publication of this amendment is not required.
- 3. The notice type issue remarks appearing on claim 41K 188174-00 served their notice purpose and should be removed from the claim.

RECOMMENDATIONS

Based on the foregoing Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, this Master recommends that the Court modify the point of diversion of claim 41K 188174-00 as described above and remove the issue remarks from the claim.

A post decree abstract of the water right claim reflecting the recommended changes is attached to this Report.
