MASTER'S REPORT

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. James M. Forsythe and Kathryn J. Forsythe ("the Forsythes") are the record owners of irrigation claim 41S 8290-00.

2. The Forsythes objected to claim 41S 8290-00 on October 11, 2022, indicating:



3. Ann K. Jolliff and Claude E. Jolliff filed the Statement of Claim for claim 41S 8290-00 on January 6, 1981. The Statement of Claim reflected a reservoir and pump as means of diversions:

Claim 41S 8290-00 was decreed without reference to the reservoir. The Forsythes' Objection to claim 41S 8290-00 on October 11, 2022, indicates "means of diversion should be "dam" as primary and "pump" as secondary.

4. As noted in the September 22, 2025 Order in this Case, the following modifications to claim 41S 8290-00 are supported by the record:



On October 2, 2025, the Forsythes filed a Response indicating agreement with the proposed means of diversion modification.

5. The January 6, 1981 Statement of Claim for claim 41S 8290-00, indicates the period of use for the irrigation use of the claim is July 15 to September 30:

The Forsythes objected to period of diversion/period of use "of the dam" noting that it should be "year round, January 1 – December 31."

- 6. A deadline was set for the Forsythes to file evidence supporting the proposed January 1 to December 31 period of diversion and period of use for claim 41S 8290-00. (Doc. 11.00).
- 7. To support the proposed January 1 to December 31 period of diversion and period of use, on October 2, 2025, the Forsythes filed the Notice of Appropriation filed by Claude E. Jolliff and Ann C. Jolliff. The Notice of Appropriation makes no reference to period of diversion and period of use, and the Forsythes state that "In the absence of a specified period of use, it is understood that the water right was intended for year-round use." (Doc. 2.00).

No legal basis was provided by the Forsythes to substantiate the year-round use of claim 41S 8290-00. Additionally, claim 41S 8290-00 is a sprinkler irrigation claim, which would not be feasible during the winter months.

8. An Order was issued setting a deadline for the Forsythes to indicate whether the following proposed modification to claim 41S 8290-00 resolves their October 11, 2022 Objection:

The Order indicated that if nothing were filed, it would be determined that the above-described modifications resolve the Forsythes' Objections to claim 41S 8290-0 and a Master's Report would be issued. (Doc. 3.00). Furthermore, the Order indicated if additional modifications were needed to resolve the Objection, documentation, along with a proposed abstract, and evidence of historical beneficial use must be filed by the deadline. Nothing was filed.

PRINCIPLES OF LAW

- 1. Section 85-2-248(2), MCA, requires that the Water Court resolve all issue remarks that are not resolved through the objection process. *See also* Rule 7, W.R.Adj.R.
- 2. A properly filed Statement of Claim for an existing water right is prima facie proof of its content. Mont. Code Ann. § 85-2-227 (2025); Rule 10, W.R.Adj.R.
- 3. Prima facie proof may be contradicted and overcome by a preponderance of the evidence. Rule 19, W.R.Adj.R. A preponderance of the evidence is evidence that shows a fact is "more probable than not." *Hohenlohe v. State*, 2010 MT 203, ¶ 33, 357 Mont. 438, 240 P.3d 628.

CONCLUSION OF LAW

1. The Objectors failed to file information to substantiate a year-round period of diversion for claim 41S 8290-00.

RECOMMENDATIONS

- 1. The means of diversion for claim 41S 8290-00 should be modified to reflect the primary means of diversion is a "dam" and the secondary means of diversion is a "pump."
 - 2. The Objection to claim 41S 8290-00 should be dismissed. An abstract is enclosed.
