MASTER'S REPORT

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Larry H. Grinde is the record owner of domestic claim 41S 30125227.
- 2. Claim 41S 30125227 was decreed with a Montana Department of Natural Resources and Conservation (DNRC) notice-type issue remark indicating the claim was not included in the Basin 41S Temporary Preliminary Decree; the remark does not require further attention.


3. Claim 41S 30125227 was decreed with the point of diversion and place of use as:

*Point of Diversion and Means of Diversion: ID 16N 19E **FERGUS** Period of Diversion: JANUARY 1 TO DECEMBER 31 Diversion Means: DEVELOPED SPRING *Place of Use: ID Govt Lot Acres County Sec 1.50 **FERGUS**

4. Grinde objected to claim 41S 30125227 on September 26, 2022, indicating:

6. A deadline was set for Claimant Larry H. Grinde to file a statement indicate whether the following proposed modification to claim 41S 30125227 resolves the Objection:



The Order indicated that if nothing were filed by the deadline, it would be concluded that Larry H. Grinde agrees the proposed modification resolves the Objection; nothing was filed by the October 24, 2025 deadline.

PRINCIPLES OF LAW

1. Section 85-2-248(2), MCA, requires that the Water Court resolve all issue remarks that are not resolved through the objection process. *See also* Rule 7, W.R.Adj.R.

- 2. A properly filed Statement of Claim for an existing water right is prima facie proof of its content. Mont. Code Ann. § 85-2-227 (2025); Rule 10, W.R.Adj.R.
- 3. Prima facie proof may be contradicted and overcome by a preponderance of the evidence. Rule 19, W.R.Adj.R. A preponderance of the evidence is evidence that shows a fact is "more probable than not." *Hohenlohe v. State*, 2010 MT 203, ¶ 33, 357 Mont. 438, 240 P.3d 628.
- 4. The Water Court may use information submitted by the DNRC, the Statement of Claim, and any other data obtained by the Court to evaluate a water right. §§ 85-2-227, -231(2), MCA.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The information in the record overcomes the prima facie status of claim 41S 30125227 and it is appropriate to modify the point of diversion.
- 2. The notice-type issue remark decree on claim 41S 30125227 has served its purpose; as no objections were filed, no further proceedings are required.

RECOMMENDATIONS

1. The point of diversion for claim 41S 30125227 should be modified as follows:
